NOTIFICATION.

No. 3442/F. & M. R.

The Mundomuzhi Reserve was constituted into a Reserved Forest by the Notification under Section 18 of Regulation II of 1068, published in the Government Gazette dated 29th Vrischigom 1074/13th December 1898. The boundaries of the Reserve have since been surveyed and cairns erected at all prominent places and a description of the boundaries of the Block with special reference to the cairns is herewith appended for general information.

Mundomuzhi.	Quilon.	Chengannore (Hills unsurveyed.)	<p><i>Situation</i> :—The block lies south of the Kumarenperur-Kallar river and north of the Koni-Achencoil road and is wedged between Koni reserve on the east and Kumarenperur reserve on the west.</p> <p><i>North</i> :—Starting from cairn No. 92 of the Kumarenperur Reserve, situated on the left bank of the Kumarenperur-Kallar river, north side of the Forest road from Vagaserikara to Mundomuzhi about 7 chains west by slightly north of the south-western corner of the Mundomuzhi Bungalow the line runs eastward along the southern side of the river for about 10 chains to cairn No. 1 (of Mundomuzhi Reserve) situated on the said bank of the same river.</p> <p><i>East</i> :—Thence south southwest along the Forest Road from Mundomuzhi to Naduvathumuzhi for about 8 chains to cairn No. 2 situated at the place where a diversion road branches off. Thence southward for about 165½ chains along the western side of the same road passing cairn No. 3 to cairn No. 4 situated on the left bank of the Athichenpara Thodu, thence more or less in the same direction along the road for about 65½ chains to cairn No. 5 situated at the junction of another diversion road with the above road, near Penanga Thodu, thence following the same road in a south-westerly direction for about 124 chains to cairn No. 6 situated at the junction of that road with the Koni-Achencoil road.</p> <p><i>South</i> :—Thence westward for about 7 chains along the north side of the Koni-Achencoil road to cairn No. 97 of Kumarenperur Reserve situated 4½ chains north of the Divisional Forest Officer's Bungalow at Naduvathumuzhi.</p> <p><i>West</i> :—Thence more or less north-east for about 25 chains to cairn No. 96 situated on a rock (from here, up to the end, the cairn Numbers given are those of the Kumarenperur Reserve) thence more or less east northeast for about 42½ chains to cairn No. 95 thence more or less north for about 1½ chains to cairn No. 94, situated on the right bank of the Athichenpara Thodu and about 11½ chains west of its junction with the Naduvathumuzhi stream, thence in the same direction to the Nedumpara hills for about 105 chains to cairn No. 93 situated on the Athichenpara which forms the water-shed between the Kumarenperur Kallar and the Achencoil rivers, thence more or less north north-east for about 83 chains to the starting point on the north boundary.</p> <p><i>Remarks</i> :—There are no public or private rights within the reserve.</p>	655.90 acres.
