NOTIFICATION.

The Mazhuvannur Reserved Forest No. 11 was constituted by the Notification under Section 18 of Regulation II of 1068, published in the Travancore Government Gazette dated 17th Medom 1071/28th April 1896 and the boundaries were revised and published on page 471 of the Government Gazette dated 2nd Medom 1083/14th April 1908. Cairns have since been erected on the boundaries of the said Reserved Forest and a correct description of the boundaries with reference to the cairns is herewith appended for the information of the public.

BOUNDARIES.

North.—Starting from cairn No. 1 on the north-west corner of the Reserve about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains north-east of the north-east corner of survey number 1013/1 the line runs east-north-east for about 9 chains passing cairn Nos. 2 and 3 to cairn No. 4; thence east-south-east for about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 5 about a chain south-west of the south-east corner of survey number 1014/6; thence more or less in the same direction for about $6\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 6; thence east by slightly north for about $4\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 7 about quarter of a chain west of the Theodolite Stone on the west side of survey number 1018/5; thence south east along the west side of the above survey number for about $3\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 8 at a Theodolite Stone; thence in the same direction for about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 9; thence southward for about $7\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn No. 10 to cairn No. 11 about 4 chains west-south-west of the south-west corner of survey number 1015/1 (the foot-path from Perumbavoor to Puthen Cruz enters the Reserve at cairn No. 11); thence east-north-east for about $14\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn Nos. 12 and 13 to cairn No. 14 about $1\frac{1}{2}$ chains south of the south-east corner of survey number 1015/1; thence north-east for about $3\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 15 about half a chain south of the south-west corner of survey number 1016/1; thence east-north-east for about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 16; thence south-east for about 4 chains to cairn No. 17 about quarter of a chain south-west of the Theodolite Stone on the west side of survey number 1016/3; thence south-south-east for about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 18 about $1\frac{1}{2}$ chains south of the south-west corner of survey number 1016/3; thence more or less east for about 7 chains passing cairn No. 19 to cairn No. 20; thence east-south-east for about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 21 about $1\frac{1}{2}$ chains north of the north-west corner of survey number 1008/1.

East.—Thence the line runs south by slightly west for about $2\frac{3}{4}$ chains to cairn No. 22; thence south-south-east for about $1\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 23 about 1 chain south-west of the south-west corner of survey number 1008/1; thence south-east for about $1\frac{3}{4}$ chains to cairn No. 24; thence south-south-east for about $3\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 25; thence south-east for about 3 chains to cairn No. 26; thence south-south-east for about $3\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 27; thence south by slightly east for about $2\frac{3}{4}$ chains to cairn No. 28; thence south-south-west for about $4\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 29 at the north-west corner of survey number 1001/1; thence in the same direction for about $4\frac{3}{4}$ chains to cairn No. 30 about 10 links west of a sharp bend on the west side of the above mentioned survey number; thence south by slightly west for about 3 chains to cairn No. 31 about $1\frac{1}{2}$ chains north-west of the trijunction of survey numbers 1001/1 and 1000/7 and 3.

South.—Thence west by slightly south for about $4\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 32; thence west-north-west for about 3 chains to cairn No. 33 about $1\frac{1}{2}$ chains north by slightly east of the north-east corner of survey number 1009/1; thence west-south-west for about $8\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn No. 34 to cairn No. 35 thence south-south-east for about 4 chains to cairn No. 36 about $1\frac{1}{2}$ chains north-west of the south-west corner of survey number 1009/1; thence west by slightly south for about $3\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 37 about half a chain north-west of the north-east corner of survey number 1010/12; thence west-north-west for about 8 chains passing cairn No. 38 to cairn No. 39; thence north-west for about $13\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn No. 40 and cairn No. 41 (at the eastern most corner of survey number 1011/7) to cairn No. 42 (the boundary line between cairn Nos. 39 and 40 touches the eastern most corner of survey number 1011/4 about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains north-west of cairn No. 39); thence in the same direction by slightly west for about $4\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 43 about $1\frac{1}{2}$ chains north-east of the northern most corner of survey number 1011/7;

thence north-north-west for about 6½ chains passing cairn No. 44 to cairn No. 45 about 2 chains north-north-east of the north-east corner of survey number 1012/2; thence west by slightly south for about 2½ chains to cairn No. 46; thence west north-west for about 2½ chains to cairn No. 47 about 2½ chains northeast of the south-east corner of survey number 1006/1-8.

West.—Thence north-north-west for about 7 chains to cairn No. 48 at a point on the east side of a survey number 1006/1-8; thence north by slightly west for about 7½ chains to cairn No. 49 about a chain north of the north-east corner of the above survey number; thence west-north-west for about 6½ chains passing cairn No. 50 to cairn No. 51 about 20 links north of the northern most corner of the said survey number thence north-west for about 9 chains passing cairn No. 52 to cairn No. 1 at the starting point on the north boundary.

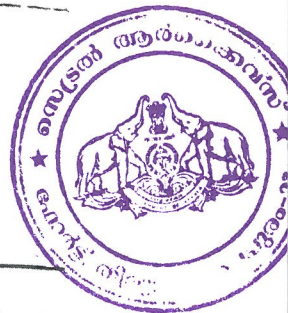

North.—Starting from cairn No. 53 at the north-west corner of the enclosure, the line runs east along its north side for about 2 chains to cairn No. 54 at its north-east corner about 7½ chains west-south-west of cairn No. 26 of the outer boundary on the east side of the Reserve.

East.—Thence south along its east side for about two chains to cairn No. 55 at its south-east corner about 8½ chains west-south west of cairn No. 27 (outer boundary).

South.—Thence west along its south side for about 2 chains to cairn No. 56 at its south-west corner.

West.—Thence north along its west side for about 2 chains to cairn No. 53 the starting point on the north boundary.

Boundaries.

North.—Starting from cairn No. 57 at the north-west corner of Nellikaithu Purayidom the line runs east along its north side for about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 58 at its north-east corner; thence south along its east side for about half a chain to cairn No. 59; thence east along the north side of Meappathu Purayidom for about 2 chains to cairn No. 60 at its north-east corner about 3 chains west of cairn No. 22 (outer boundary).

East.—Thence the line runs south along the east side of the last mentioned Purayidom for about 2 chains to cairn No. 61 at its south-east corner, about $3\frac{1}{2}$ chains west-south-west of cairn No. 23 (outer boundary).

South.—Thence west along its south side for about 2 chains to cairn No. 62 at its south west corner, thence in the same direction along the south side of Nellikayathu purayidom for about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 63 at its south-west corner.

West.—Thence north along the west side of the above purayidom for about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 57 the starting point on the north boundary.

North.—Starting from cairn No. 64 at the north-west corner of Punnayil Purayidom the line runs east for about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 65 at its north-east corner about $5\frac{1}{2}$ chains west of cairn No. 29 on the north-west corner of survey number 1021/1-1; thence south along its east side for about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 66 at its south-east corner; thence east for about $2\frac{1}{4}$ chains along the north side of Punnayil Kudi Mial to cairn No. 67 at its north-east corner about $3\frac{1}{2}$ chains south-west of the said cairn No. 29.

East.—Thence south along its east side for about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 68 at its south-east corner about $1\frac{1}{2}$ chains west of cairn No. 30 (outer boundary).

South.—Thence west along its south side for about $5\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 69 at its south-west corner.

West.—Thence north for about $4\frac{1}{2}$ chains along the west side of the above Mial and that of Punnayil Purayidom to cairn No. 64 the starting point on the north boundary.

II. PUBLIC RIGHTS ADMITTED WITHIN THE RESERVE.**A. THE FOOT-PATH FROM PERUMBAVOOR TO PUTHEN CRUZ.**

The above foot-path 3 feet wide enters the Reserve at cairn No. 11 on the north boundary of the Reserve and runs in a more or less south-westerly direction for about 12 chains and leaves the Reserve between cairns Nos. 45 and 46 on the southern boundary about a chain west of the former cairn.

B. FOOT-PATH LEADING TO THE ENCLOSURE B AND TO ENCLOSURE A (SACRED GROVE).

The above foot-path 3 feet wide enters the Reserve between cairns Nos. 18 and 19 on the north boundary about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains east of the former cairn and goes in a more or less south-easterly

direction for about 3 chains to meet enclosure B on its north side about quarter of a chain west of cairn No. 58. Thence in the same direction for about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains through the enclosure and leaves it at cairn No. 62. Thence south-east for about $7\frac{1}{2}$ chains; thence south-west for about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains to meet the enclosure A on its north boundary about $\frac{3}{4}$ chains west of cairn No. 54 on its north-east corner.

C. FOOT-PATH TO ENCLOSURE C.

The above foot-path 3 feet wide enters the Reserve at cairn No. 30 on the east side of the Reserve and runs west for about $1\frac{1}{2}$ chains and enters the enclosure at cairn No. 68 on the south-east corner of Punnayil Kudi Mial.

REMARKS.

There are no other rights within the Reserve either private or public than those specified above.

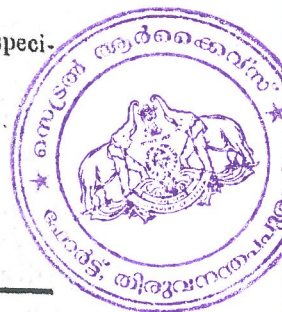
