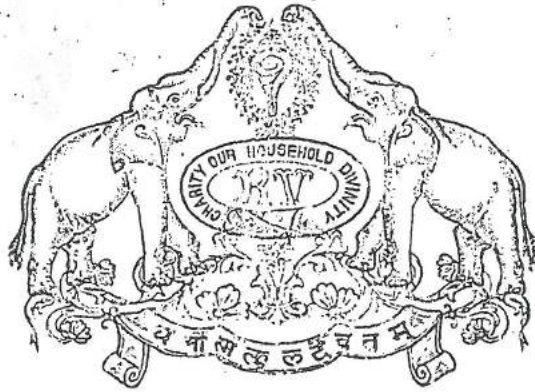

NOTIFICATION.

The Thattakad Reserved Forest was constituted by the Notification under Section 18 of Regulation II of 1938 published in the Travancore Government Gazette dated 24th March 1903 corresponding to 11th Panguuni 1978. Cairns have since been erected on the boundaries of the said Reserved Forest and a description of the boundaries with special reference to the cairns is herewith appended for general information.

Kuttamangalam.	<p>Situation :—The block lies on either side of the Kothamangalam - Munnar road (High Range road) between its 5th and 7th mile stones and comprises survey numbers 491/1, 492/1, 485/1, 486/1, 493/1, 500/1, 526/1, 531/1, 537/1, 455/1, 459/1, 538/1 B, 533/1 and portions of survey numbers 488/1, 496/2, 496/3, 524/1, 532/1 B, 538/2 B, 538/1 B, 559/1 and 458/1 of Kuttamangalam <i>pakuthi</i>, Muvattupuzha taluk.</p> <p>North :—Starting from cairn No. 1 at the village boundary stone situated at the south west corner of survey number 490/1 of Kuttamangalam <i>pakuthi</i>, the line goes eastward skirting survey number 490/1 and passing cairn numbers 2 to 15 to cairn number 16 at its north-eastern corner. (All the above cairns are put up at Theodolite stations). Thence east along village boundary between Kuttamangalam and Kothamangalam on the north side of survey number 491/1 to meet the Periyar river on the north east corner of the said survey number; thence southward along the Revenue survey line on the left bank of the river to cairn 17 on the Theodolite stone at the northern most corner of survey number 493/1. Survey Number 536/1-A extending to 2.88 acres registered and admitted as an enclosure within the Reserve at the time of the Forest Settlement and declared free from reservation is now excluded by ring boundaries cut around it as described below:—

North:—Starting from cairn No. 318 at the north west corner of survey number 536/1-A, the line runs along the north side of the above survey number for about $4\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn No. 319 to cairn No. 320 at its north east corner.

East:—Thence along its east side passing cairn Nos. 321 to 323 to cairn No. 324 at its south east corner.

South:—Thence along its south side to cairn No. 325 at its south west corner.

West:—Thence along its west side for about 8 chains to cairn No. 318 at the starting point on the north boundary.

II. PUBLIC RIGHTS NOW ADMITTED.

A. The High Range road from Kuthamangalam to Munnar forming a portion of the southern boundary of the reserve between cairn Nos. 161 and 160 enters the reserve at the latter cairn situated near the north west corner of survey number 559/1 and after running through the reserve in an almost north easterly direction for about $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles leaves the reserve between cairn Nos. 43 and 44 of the east boundary at about $1\frac{1}{2}$ chains west of the latter cairn.

B. I. *Thattakad Kuttikal Forest road 12 ft. wide* starts at about 2 chains north of the Theodolite station on the High Range road about 6 chains south south east of cairn No. 43 and after running more or less in a north westerly direction for about 58 chains leaves the reserve just north of cairn No. 37 and again enters the reserve at cairn No. 35 and after running west north west for $1\frac{1}{2}$ chains thence northward for about 3 chains again leaves the reserve about $\frac{1}{2}$ a chain south of cairn No. 34. The same road again enters the reserve about a chain south west of cairn No. 17 and after running westward for about 15 chains within the reserve meets the old Kuttikal guard station situated in survey number 491/1. This road is admitted mainly to give access to survey numbers 493/1, 494/1 and to the path leading to Chanthirathil chal.

II. A foot path 6 ft. wide, for the use of men and cattle of Kurikulam and Odappanai fields starts from the 6th mile stone of the High Range road and after running through the reserve in an almost easterly direction for about 44 chains leaves the reserve between cairn Nos. 117 and 118 at about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a chain south of the former cairn.

III. A foot path 3 ft. wide for the use of men from the High Range road to Palamattom, enters the reserve on the east boundary at cairn No. 47 and after running through the reserve in a south easterly direction for about 14 chains leaves it at cairn No. 50.

IV. A foot path 6 ft. wide is granted to give access to the lands in Chanthirathil chal and it starts from Thattakad Kooty road at about a chain south south west of cairn No. 34 and after running west north west for about 24 chains leaves the reserve between cairn Nos. 290 and 291 on the western boundary at about a chain north of the former cairn.

V. A foot-path 6 ft. wide is granted to give access to survey numbers 525/1 to 5 and it starts from the High Range road $3\frac{1}{2}$ chains south of the 3rd furling of the 7th mile and after running through the reserve in an easterly direction for about 9 chains leaves the reserve between cairn Nos. 88 and 89 at about $3\frac{1}{2}$ chains south of the former cairn.

VI. A foot-path 3 ft wide for giving access to the lands comprised in Chelamalakandam starts from the High Range Road $1\frac{1}{2}$ chains north of the 2nd furlong stone of 7th mile and runs in an almost north westerly direction for about $5\frac{1}{2}$ chains to meet the Theodolite Kandom line thence north west along the same Kandom line for about 18 chains and then leaves the reserve between cairn Nos. 243 and 241 at about 2 chains north west of the former cairn.

VII. A foot-path 6 ft. wide is granted to give access to enclosure (Survey number 536/1 A) and it starts from the High Range road about $1\frac{1}{2}$ chains south of the Theodolite stone at the southern most corner of survey number 533/1 and after running through the reserve in an almost north westerly direction for about 15 chains, thence northward for about 3 chains meets cairn No. 325 on the south west corner of the enclosure.

VIII. Another foot-path 6 ft. wide starting from the foot-path No. VII about $6\frac{1}{2}$ chains south east of cairn No. 324 and after running through the reserve in a westerly direction for about 14 chains, leaves the reserve at a point about $\frac{1}{2}$ a chain south of cairn No. 183. This gives access to the lands known as Thekkumal Nilam.

IX. A path 6 ft. wide for the use of men and cattle starts from the High Range road at a point about $3\frac{1}{2}$ chains south of the south east corner of survey number 459/1 and after running through the reserve in a more or less south easterly direction for about 4 chains, leaves the reserve at cairn No. 144. This path is also allowed for the access to the lands in Kurikulam, Kythakandam and Odappanal fields.

X. A path 6 ft. wide for the use of men and cattle of Kurikulam and Odappanal fields starts at about half a chain north of cairn No. 110 and after running through the reserve in a south easterly direction for about 7 chains, leaves the reserve between cairn Nos. 120 and 121 at about $1\frac{1}{2}$ chains south west of the former cairn.

The following Press Communique of the Government of India dated 26th February 1917, on the subject of the prohibition of the importation of various articles into the United Kingdom is republished for general information.

Press Communique of the Government of India, Department of Commerce and Industry, dated Delhi, the 26th February 1917:—

Owing to the necessity for economising tonnage the Home Government have now issued a Proclamation prohibiting with effect from 23rd February 1917, the importation of various articles into the United Kingdom. A list of prohibited imports is being published in a Gazette Extraordinary. With regard to the articles in which India is principally interested viz., raw jute and tea, the Government of India are issuing a Notification prohibiting the export to the United Kingdom on private account. In the case of raw jute the visible supplies in the United Kingdom are estimated to be sufficient for the requirements of 1917, and the Government of India regret that it will not be possible to allow export to the United Kingdom on private account for the present. Export of tea however will be allowed to the extent of 7,000 tons monthly on the average, this figure being inclusive of tea purchased by the War Office.

NOTIFICATION.

No. 2045/L. R./703 of 16.

Under sanction of His Highness the Maha Raja, it is hereby notified that Paragraph 1 of Rule 26 of the Rules for the sale of waste land for coffee or tea cultivation, dated the 28th November 1913, as amended by Notifications Nos. 1415/L. R. & 4401/L. R., dated the 20th February 1915, and 5th July 1916, respectively, is farther amended as follows:—

"The full proprietorship of all Royal trees, viz., Teak, Black wood, Ebony and Sandalwood, within the grant, vests in the Government. The number and description of such trees shall be entered in the Schedule attached to the title deed for the land and the grantee shall be bound to take care of the trees until they are removed or otherwise disposed of by the Government. In regard to Reserved trees, the grantee shall pay the value of all such timber as is actually used for building purposes within the limits of the grant or removed outside its limits for any purpose whatsoever. In no other case will the grantee be required to pay for the Reserved trees on the land comprised within the grant."
