

**RESERVE NOTIFICATION****KUMARAMPEROOR RESERVE****Government Gazette No.47 Dated 20.11.1917/4.4.1093**

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No.4275/F. &amp;M. R. /192 of 15.

It is hereby notified under Section 18 of the forest Regulation II of 1068, as amended by Regulations IV of 1071 and IX of 1085, that from and after this date, the tract specified in the subjoined schedule shall be deemed a Reserved forest.

**N.B:** The area described below was notified under section 4 of the above Regulation separately as Kumaramperoor North, Kumaranparoor South and Kumaramperoor Extension Reserves, vide Government Gazette Nos. 20 dated 20<sup>th</sup> May 1902/7<sup>th</sup> Edavom 1077, and 11 dated 15<sup>th</sup> March 1910/ 2<sup>nd</sup> Meenom 1085. But for the sake of convenience they are now constituted and notified as one block, hence forth to be known as Kumaramperoor Reserve.

**North:-** Starting from cairn No.1. situated about 3 chains south-south- east of the south west corner of survey No.749/1 of Ranni village, the boundary runs east for a distance of about 5 chains to cairn No.2, thence east north-east for about 13 chains passing cairn No.3 to cairn No. 4, thence east for about 16 ½ chains passing cairn No.5 to cairn No.6, thence more or less south east for about 30 chains passing cairn Nos.7 to 10 to cairn No.11 situated about 10 chains south west of the north western corner of survey No.938/1 thence south southwest for about 19 chains passing cairn No.12 and crossing the Vadasserikara- Rajampara cart road to cairn No.13 at the south western corner of the said survey No, thence south east and more or less along the southern limits of survey Nos.938/1,936/1 and 936/1 and 935/1 for about 41 ½ chains passing cairn Nos.14 to 18 to cairn No.19 about 7 chains east of the south western corner of survey No.935/1, thence in the same direction for about 22 chains passing cairn Nos. 20 to 22 to cairn No.23 on the south side of survey No.934/2 about 8 chains south east of its south west corner, thence east more or less along the southern limits of the survey Nos. 934/2 and 933/1 for a distance of about 14 chains passing cairn Nos.24 and 25 to cairn No.26, then south east more or less along the southern limits of the survey Nos.933/1 and 932/1, for about 26 chains passing cairn Nos. 27 to 29 to cairn Nos. 30 near the south eastern corner of survey No. 932/1, thence east for about 5 chains to cairn No.21, thence south east for about 30 chains passing cairn Nos. 32 and 33 to cairn No.34, thence east south east for about 21 chains passing cairn No.35 to cairn No.36, thence north east for about 26 chains passing cairn Nos.37 to 41 to cairn No.42 situated on the west bank of the Kakkadu river, thence east ward along the same bank of the said river for a distance of about 437 chains to cairn No.43 on its left bank situated just opposite to the Chittar Guard Station on the right bank of the river and about 4 ¼ chains east of the north eastern corner of the survey No 942/1.

**East:-** The boundary is identical with the western boundaries of the Konni and Mundomoozhy reserves, from cairn No. 43 the boundary runs more or less south for about 17 ½ chains passing cairn Nos. 44 to 46 to cairn No. 47 about 2 chains west of the north western corner of survey number 346/5 (Chittar Estate) thence again in the same direction more or less along the western side of the Chittar Estate for about 70

chains passing cairn Nos. 48 to 69 and also crossing the Chittar cart road at cairn No. 53 to cairn 70, thence south west for about 11 ½ chains passing cairn nos. 71 to 73 to cairn No. 74, thence south by the western side of the same estate for about 47 ½ chains passing cairn Nos. 75 to 84 to cairn No. 85, thence south east for about 8 chains to cairn No.85 A, thence south west for about 16 ½ chains to cairn No. 86, thence west southwest for 75 ½ chains to cairn No. 87, thence more or less southerly for 131 chains to cairn No. 88 at Anjukuzhi niravu, the source of the Karingal thode, thence more or less southerly for about 110 chains to cairn No.89 on a rock on the top of a small hill, thence more or less south west for about 41 ½ chains to cairn No. 90 on a saddle about 5 ¼ chains east of a rock locally known as Kunthanakuzhi kotta, thence south for about 105 chains to cairn No. 91 on the right bank of the Kumaramperoor Kallar river, thence crossing the river in a southerly direction for about 3 ¾ chains to cairn No. 92 situated on the left bank of the river and on the bridle path from Vadasserikkara to Mundomoozhy and 7 ¼ chains north west of the south western corner of the Mundomoozhy Bungalow (the boundary described above from cairn Nos. 43 to 92 forms the western boundary of the Konni reserve) from cairn No. 92 the boundary leaving the western boundary of the Konni reserve follows the western boundary of the Mundomoozhy reserve in a more or less southerly direction for about 367 chains passing cairn No. 93 at Athichenpara, 94 at Athichenpara Thode and 95 and 96 to cairn No. 97 on the northern side of the Konni Achencoil road and about 4 ½ chains north of the Divisional Forest Officer's Bungalow at Naduvathumoozhy, thence southerly for about 11 ½ chains along the western boundary of the Konni Reserve and crossing the above mentioned Bungalow to cairn No. 98 on the right bank of the Achencoil river about 13 chains west of the junction of the Naduvathumoozhy stream with the river, thence leaving the boundary of the Konni Reserve, crosses the river to cairn No. 99 on the left bank of the said river.

**South:-** Thence north west along the left bank of the said river to cairn No. 1 of Anakulam Reserve North Block, thence north crossing the river to cairn No. 100 on the right bank of the river, thence along the same bank down the river for a distance of about 49 chains to cairn No. 7 of the Vattappara Reserve. Thence along the eastern and

northern boundaries of that Reserve passing its cairn Nos. 6c, 6b and 6a to cairn No. 6 of the same Reserve situated at the right bank of the Kummannoor stream and by the side of the Konni Achencoil road.

**West:-** Thence leaving the Vattappara Reserve northward along the right bank of the Kummannoor stream for a distance of  $17 \frac{3}{4}$  chains to cairn No. 101 of this Reserve (Kumaramperoor Reserve) situated on the same bank of the same stream, thence north west for about 9 chains passing cairn No. 102 to cairn No. 103, thence north for about 2 chains to cairn No. 104 about  $5 \frac{1}{4}$  chains east of the north eastern corner of survey No.552/2 of Kumbazha Pakuthy , thence north for about 17 chains passing cairn Nos. 105 and 106 to cairn No. 107, thence north west for 8 chains passing cairn No. 108 to cairn No.109, thence north for about  $19 \frac{1}{2}$  chains passing cairn No. 110 to 113 to cairn No. 114 on a rock in a saddle and about 12 chains east of the south eastern corner of survey No. 549/1 Kumbazha Pakuthy thence northward for about 13 chains to cairn No. 118 situated on the eastern slope of rock called Nedumpara, thence east north east for  $6 \frac{1}{3}$  chains to cairn No. 119, thence north east for about  $27 \frac{1}{4}$  chains passing cairn Nos. 120 to 125 to cairn No. 126, thence north west for about  $17 \frac{1}{2}$  chains passing cairn Nos.127 and 128 to cairn No. 129, thence north for about  $5 \frac{1}{4}$  chains to cairn No. 130 of a flat rock and about  $3 \frac{2}{3}$  chains east of a bend on the north east side of survey No. 567/1, thence more or less north for  $18 \frac{3}{4}$  chains passing cairn Nos. 131 and 132 to cairn No. 133 at Kadikkuzhy situated at the south eastern corner of the survey No. 569/1 of Kumbazha hills, thence northerly along the east side of the said survey number passing cairn No. 134 to 138 to cairn No. 139 at its north eastern corner, thence east along the southern side of survey No. 581 for about 30 chains passing cairn No. 140 to cairn No. 141 on the left bank of the Vappila thode, thence north along the left bank of the same thode to cairn No. 142 situated opposite to the junction of the Gnalloor Thodu with Vappilathode thence again northerly along the same bank of the Vappilathode to cairn No. 143, situated opposite of the junction of the Kakkarakudy thode with Vappilathode thence in the same direction for a distance for about  $3 \frac{1}{2}$  chains to cairn No. 144 at the north western corner of survey No. 578, thence north east along the north side of survey Nos. 578/1 for about  $45 \frac{1}{2}$  chains passing cairn Nos. 145 to 152

and crossing the Vadasserikkara Mundomoozhy bridle path to cairn No. 153 on the left bank of the Kallar river at Vilangukallu, thence east north east crossing the river to cairn No. 154 on the right bank of said Kallar river, thence more or less north west along the said bank for a distance of about 296 chains to cairn No. 155 at Vilayadimuzhi thence west again crossing the river to cairn No. 156 situated on its left bank, thence westward for about 136 chains crossing the said path and along the north side of Cheralical belonging to the Vanjipuzha Chief and passing cairn Nos. 157 to 195 to cairn No. 196 at the village boundary stone at Mukkuzhy pass and north eastern corner of survey No. 602/2 of Kumbazha along the village boundary between Ranni and Kumbazha for  $3\frac{1}{2}$  chains to cairn No. 197, thence in the same direction for about  $36\frac{1}{4}$  chains and south of the said village boundary line passing cairn Nos. 198 to 206 to cairn No. 207 situated on the village boundary, thence westward along the above village boundary, for about 18 chains passing cairn No. 208 to cairn No. 209 thence more or less north for about 42 chains passing cairn numbers 210 to 217 to cairn number 218 thence west south west for about 14 chains passing cairn Nos. 219 to 221 to cairn No. 222, thence north west for about  $49\frac{3}{4}$  chains passing cairn Nos. 223 to 232 to cairn No. 233 about 2 chains south east of the north eastern corner of survey No. 699/2 (Kumanoli nilam) of Ranni village, thence north east for about 10 chains passing cairn Nos. 234 and 235 to cairn No. 236, thence north northeast for about 23 chains passing cairn Nos. 237 to 241 to cairn No. 242 situated by the side of Edathara field, thence eastward for about  $32\frac{2}{3}$  chains passing cairn Nos. 243 to 249 to cairn No. 250 thence south east for  $19\frac{1}{2}$  chains passing cairn Nos. 251 to 253 to cairn No. 254 situated  $6\frac{3}{4}$  chains south west of the south eastern corner of survey No. 707/1 of Ranni village, thence in the same direction for about  $12\frac{3}{4}$  chains passing cairn No. 255 to cairn No. 256 situated about  $\frac{1}{4}$  of a chain south of the southern most corner of survey No. 708/2 (Vavolikandam), thence eastward for about 19 chains passing cairn No. 257 to 261 to cairn No. 262 at Theendakattungalkavu thence south east for about  $14\frac{3}{4}$  chains passing cairn Nos. 263 to cairn No. 264 on a saddle above Iruttuthodemoozhy, thence in the same direction for about 10 chains passing cairn Nos. 265 to 267 to cairn No. 268, thence south southeast for about 24 chains passing cairn Nos. 269 to 273 to cairn No. 274 on the right bank of the Iruttuthode thence north east along the same bank of the same stream for about  $13\frac{3}{4}$

chains passing cairn No. 275 to cairn No. 276, thence south east for about 17 ½ chains passing cairn Nos. 277 to 279 to cairn No. 280 thence east for about 2 chains to cairn No. 281, thence more or less north for about 18 chains passing cairn Nos. 282 to 286 and recrossing the said bridle path to cairn No. 287 on the eastern side of survey No. 702/1 and on the left bank of the Kumaramperoor Kallar river, thence north crossing the river to cairn No. 288 on the right bank of the river, thence north north west for about 14 ¾ chains passing cairn Nos. 289 to 291 to cairn No. 292 thence east south east for about 18 1/3 chains passing cairn Nos. 293 to 295 to cairn No. 296, thence north for 6 1/3 chains passing cairn No. 297 to cairn No. 298, thence west north west for about 15 chains passing cairn No. 299 to 300 to cairn 301 thence north for about 3 ¼ chains to cairn No. 302 at the south eastern corner of survey No. 928/1, thence skirting that survey number and passing cairn Nos. 303 to 305 to cairn No. 306 situated about 2 chains east of its north western corner, thence north northwest for about 22 chains passing cairn Nos. 307 to 310 to cairn 311 on the east side of survey No. 927/4 about 5chains south of its north east corner, thence north along the east side of the survey number to cairn No. 312 at the above said corner, thence south east for about 12 ½ chains passing cairn No. 313 to cairn No. 314, thence more or less north for about 18 ¼ chains passing cairn Nos. 315 to 317 to cairn No. 318, thence more or less east for about 15 ½ chains passing cairn Nos.319 and 320 to cairn No. 321, thence north northeast for about 9 chains to cairn no. 322, thence north west for about 49 chains passing cairn No. 323 and crossing the Vadasserikkara Chittar cart road to cairn No. 324, thence more or less north west for about 16 ½ chains passing cairn Nos. 325 to 329 to cairn No. 330 thence more or less east for about 8 chains passing cairn Nos. 331 and 332 to cairn No. 333, thence south east for about 6 3/4 chains passing cairn No. 334 to cairn No. 335, thence north northwest for about 17 chains passing cairn Nos. 336 to 339 to cairn No. 1 at the starting point on the north boundary.

**North:-** Starting from cairn No. 1 at the north west corner of survey No.939/1 of Ranni Pakuthy and on the left bank of the Kakkad river the line goes eastward along the north side of this number, passing cairn Nos. 2 to 18 to cairn No. 19 on the road from Vadasserikkara to Chittar, thence to cairn No. 20 at the north east corner of this survey number (ie. On the western limit of survey No.940/1).

**East:-** Thence southward along the east side of this survey number for about 4 chains to cairn No. 21, thence south west along the south side of the above survey number for about 12 chains to cairn No.22.

**South:-** Thence west for about 22 chains along the south side of the said survey number passing cairn No.23 to cairn No. 24 thence north for about 3 ¼ chains to cairn No. 25 situated on the cart road to Chittar, thence westward for about 10 ¼ chains to along the above cart road to cairn No. 26, thence west for about 9 ½ chains to cairn No. 27, thence south for 7 chains to cairn No. 28 thence south west for about 7 chains to cairn No. 29, thence west by slightly north for about 18 ¾ chains passing cairn No. 30 to cairn No. 31.

**West:-** Thence north for about  $8 \frac{3}{4}$  chains along the west side of survey No. 939/1A passing cairn No. 32 on the north side of the above cart road to cairn No. 33, thence more or less north east along the west side of the above survey number passing cairn no. 34 to 39 to cairn No. 1 at the starting point.

Access to this registered holding is granted by the cart road to Chittar, admitted and described below under public rights.

**North:-** Starting from cairn No. 1 on the north west corner of survey No.940/1-1 the line goes south east for about 10 chains passing cairn Nos. 2 and 3 to cairn No.4, thence north northeast for about  $9\frac{3}{4}$  chains passing cairn Nos. 5 to 7 to cairn 8, thence south east for about  $21 \frac{1}{2}$  chains passing cairn Nos. 9 to 12 to cairn No. 13 (the boundary between cairn Nos. 1 to 13 follow the north side of survey No. 940/1-1)

**East:-** Thence more or less south along the east side of the said survey number for about  $20 \frac{1}{4}$  chains passing cairn Nos. 14 to 17 to cairn No.18.

**South:-** Thence westward along the south side of the above survey number passing cairn Nos. 19 to 26 to cairn No. 27.

**West:-** Thence north along the west side of the above survey number for  $9 \frac{2}{3}$  chains to cairn No. 1 at the starting point.

Access to this registered holding is granted by a path 15 links in breadth and  $8 \frac{3}{4}$  chains in length. This path starts from the cart road to Chittar from a point about one



chain north of the cairn No. 19 of enclosure A, and goes eastward to meet cairn No.1 of this enclosure.

**East:-** Thence south along its east side for about 7 chains to cairn No. 3.

**South:-** Thence west northwest along its south side for about 27 chains to cairn No.4 .

**West:-** Thence north along its west side for about 7 ½ chains to cairn No.1 at the starting point.

Access to this registered holding is granted by a path 15 links in breadth and about 6 ½ chains to length branching off in a southerly direction from the cart road to Chittar about 11 chains west of the 14<sup>th</sup> milestone and entering the registered holding near cairn No. 2.

**East:-** Thence south for about 15 chains to cairn No. 3.

**South:-** Thence west for about  $14 \frac{2}{3}$  chains to cairn No. 4.

**West:-** Thence north for about 15 chains to cairn No. 1 at the starting point.

Access to this registered holding is granted by a path 15 links in breadth which starts from a point in the cart road to Chittar about 2 chains west of the cairn No. 53 of this Reserve and after running in a northerly direction for about 20.8 chains enters the registered holding near cairn No. 3.

**North:-** Starting from cairn No. 1 at the north western corner of survey No.929/1 the line goes along the northern side of survey Nos. 929/1 & 2 passing cairn Nos. 2 to 4 to cairn No. 5 at the north east corner of 929/2.

**East:-** Thence south along the east side of that survey number to cairn No. 6 at its south east corner, thence in the same direction for about 1 chain to cairn No. 7 on the right bank of the Karingal thode.

**South:-** Thence westward along the same bank of the same stream for about 55 chains to cairn No. 8.

**West:-** Thence north for about 5 chains to cairn No. 9 at the south west corner of survey No. 929/1, thence northward along the west side of the above survey No. passing cairn Nos. 10 & 11 to cairn No. 1 at the starting point.

Access to this enclosure is granted by a 6 ft. path. It starts from a point in the Vadasserikkara Mundomoozhy Forest trace (bridle path) about 17 chains south of the junction of the Karingal thode with the Kallar river and goes eastward for about 100 chains and enters the enclosure on its western boundary near cairn No. 9.

#### BOUNDARIES

**North:-** Starting from cairn No. 1 at the north west corner of survey No.923/1-5, the line goes south east for about 1 ½ chains to cairn No.2 situated by the western side of the cart road to Perunad Estate and about 12 chains south of the ferry of the road across the Kakkad river.

**East:-** Thence south east by the western side of the above road for 8 ½ chains to cairn No. 3.

**South:-** Thence west by slightly south for 3 chains to cairn No.4.

**West:-** Thence north west for about  $3\frac{3}{4}$  chains to cairn No. 1 at the starting point.

### **PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY AND C**

1. **Vadasserikkara Chittar Road:** This cart road 40 feet in width enters the reserves about  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a chain south of cairn No. 324 and goes in a south easterly direction for about 3 miles upto Maniyar Guard Station and thence eastward for about  $6\frac{3}{4}$  miles to meet the eastern boundary of the Reserve just north of cairn No. 53 thence leaves this Reserve.
2. **Cart Road from Maniyar to Perinad Estate:** This road 40 feet in width branches off from the Vadasserikkara Chittar road at the bridge over the Maniyar stream (or Maniyar Guard Station) and goes northward for about  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a mile to the Perinadu Estate.
3. **Vadasserikkara – Rajampara Cart Road:** This road 40 feet width branches off from the Vadasserikkara Chittar road from a point about 18 chains north of cairn No. 322 and goes north west for about of  $\frac{3}{4}$  a mile and exit the Reserve at cairn No. 13 of the northern boundary of this reserve.
4. **Konni – Achencoil Bridle Path:** This trace enters the Reserve near the cairn No. 6 of the Vattappara Reserve and goes in a south east direction for about  $2\frac{1}{2}$  miles and through the teak plantation areas and exist the Reserve near cairn No. 97 of the eastern boundary of this reserve. The average width of the trace is  $22\frac{1}{2}$  links.
