No.263:- Under section 16 of the Madras Forest Act (v of 1882) the Governor in council is pleased to declare that the area the Boundaries of which are described in the schedule below shall be constituted a reserved forest with effect from 15th August 1934.

Boundaries

North:- Starting from the tri-junction stone of Belure ,final survey notified at page 20 of the District Gazette dated 20th February 1934, Panathadi suravey Finally notified at page 36 of the District Gazette, dated 20th April 1934 and Maloth survey finaly notified at page 36 of the District Gazette, dated 20th April 1934 villages situated on the Kotakalla Guddai the common village boundary of Maloth and Panathadi villages F lines 305,267,172,229,153,557,377,284,150, 541,427,286,232,117,513,265,361,199,250,589,186,248,401,132,229,305,98,290,49 9,223 cutting the Pallikaklam chal at a point 123 links east of the stone at the Junction of F lines 499 and 223,266,798, and 442 to the north-western corner of R.S No. 30 Maloth village; thence the western and southern sides of the same R.S.No.30 ('F'lines 194 ,292,266,118,500,265)to the south-west Corner of R.S.No.31 of Maloth; sides R.s No.31 there after the southern of 125,513,300,302,212,244,and 177) and of Rs no 30 (F line 347 to the village boundary thence the common village boundary of Maloth and Panathadi villages (F line

South:-Thence from the trijunction stone R.S.Nos 32 and 112 of Maloth village and the boundary of kinnanur village survey finally notified at pages 134 and 135 of the District Gazet 25th September 1933 situated at Mundathadam along the common village boundary of Maloth and kinnanur village F lines 203,508,390,587, 427,411,724,384,642,151,348,169,210,228,196,142,368,552,257,494,514,508,505,

West:-thence the commonvillage boundary of Maloth Belur villages (F lines 539,226,260,293,102,302,315,165,370,464,130,65,290,290,336,112,380,288,234, 258,367,72,74,418,291,256,200,310,384,122,457,372,324,335,301,699,206,381,317 and 106 to the starting point.

Remarks:- I. the following enclosure which has been demarcated at resurvey exists free from reservations within the limits of the reserved Forest.

Local name: Palikala; Resurvey No.29; extent acres 17 cents38; assessed at annas two per acre; situated near the north esastern corner of the western half of the Reserved Forest nad near the northern boundary contains at present, only 'Kochi' (re rowth after heavy 'kumari' cultivation in the past) held at present on ryotwari tenure by Puttadar No,10 Abdulla Bear

Boundaries of enclosure :- North F lines 422,263,205,and 765 East F lines 879,59,and 684,south F lines 779;west F line 1271

Approach Patj(nearly prescribed)to enclosure :-it enters the reserve at the Resurvey stone at the junction of F lines 194 of R.s. No 30 of Maloth village and 442 on the common boundary of Maloth and panathady villages runs westwards for a distance of 270 links and enters the enclosure at the north eastern corner point of R.S. No. 29 rock mark at the junction of F. lines 765 and 879 of R.S.No. 29 45 links width.

II The following public right of way to a width of 45 links open to men and cattle is admitted within the reserved Forest. The footpath from pullikallu to koormanam.

It enters the Reserved Forest northwards onits southern boundary at a point 4 links west of Resurvey stone at the junction of F. lines 490 and 576 of R.S. of R. S. 28 of Maloth village runs westwards and northwards of a distance of 12 ½ chains and leaves the reserved forest northwards on its northern boundary at a point 30 links east of the Resurvey rock mark connecting F lines 500 and 265 of resurvery No. 30 of Maloth village.
