(c) for the entry "Re. -7-6" appearing, against the first entry to sub-item (9), read "Re. 0-7-6."
13. For the word "adopted" occurring in line 5 of column 2 of Item No. 76 A, read "adapted."
14. (a) In Item No. 79, insert an asterisk (*) at the end of the entry in column 2.
(b) In Item No. 83 A, delete the asterisk (*) occurring at the end of the entry in column 2.
(c) Read the foot note appearing at the bottom of page 22 as relating to Item No. 79.
15. For the entry "10 por cent" occurring in column 5 of Item No. 96, read "10 per cent."
16. For the entry "wt" occurring in column 3 of Item No. 103 b, read "cwt."
17. Against the entries relating to Iron or steel expanded metal appearing at the close of Item No. 103 b and in the column provided for Item No., insert the figure "103 c."
18. For the words and figures "or 178 annas" occurring in column 5 of Item No. 121, read "or 1 7/8 annas."
19. Against the entries relating to News-papers, old in bales and bags occurring in line 3 of item No. 144 and against the column provided for Item No., insert the figure "145".

Name of Reserve: Karayur Sandal Reserve Block No. II.
Revenue Division: Devicolam.
Taluk: Devicolam.
Village: No. 3 Kilanthur (Anjanad Tract).
Area: 240.30 acres.

Situation: The block is situated on the east side of the Karayur Village and comprises of the whole of S. Nos. 100/1, 264/1 and portions of S. Nos. 1/1, 264/2, 290/2 and 268/1 of Kilanthur pakuthi, Devicolam Taluk.

BOUNDARIES.

North: Starting from cairn No. 1 at the north west corner of the reserve about 13 3/4 chains north north east of a theodolite station at the north east corner of S. No. 289/1 of the Kilanthur pakuthi the line goes east south east for about 2 1/2 chains to cairn No. 2, thence east north east for about 4 1/4 chains to cairn No. 3, thence south east for about 2 1/2 chains to cairn No. 4, thence more or less east for about 6 1/4 chains passing cairn No. 5 to cairn No. 6.
East: Thence south by slightly east for about 5 chains passing cairn No. 7 to cairn No. 8, thence south for about 3 1/4 chains to cairn No. 9, thence south west for about 5 3/4 chains passing cairn No. 10 cairn No. 11, thence more or less south for about 10 1/2 chains passing cairn No. 12 to cairn No. 13, thence in the same direction for about 16 1/4 chains passing cairn Nos. 14 to 16 to cairn No. 17 (the line crosses a stream between cairn Nos. 15 and 16), thence south east for about 8 3/4 chains (crossing a stream between cairn Nos. 17 and 18) passing cairn Nos. 18 and 19 to cairn No. 20, thence south west for about 16 chains passing cairn Nos. 21 to 25 to cairn No. 26 at a theodolite station on the eastern boundary of S. No. 290/2 (the line crosses a stream between cairn Nos. 20 and 21 and another near cairn No. 22), thence west south west for about 6 1/2 chains through S. No. 290/2 passing cairn Nos. 27 and 28 to cairn No. 29, thence more or less south for about 8 chains passing cairn Nos. 30 to 32 to cairn No. 33 (the line crosses a stream between cairn Nos. 29 and 30), thence south east for about 10 1/2 chains passing cairn Nos. 34 and 35 to cairn No. 36 (the line crosses the southern boundary of S. No. 290/2 between cairn Nos. 33 and 34), thence south west for about 3 1/4 chains crossing a stream to cairn No. 37, thence west south west for about 1 chain to cairn No. 38 thence south west for about 5 1/2 chains passing cairn No. 39 to cairn No. 40, thence south for about 1 3/4 chains to cairn No. 41, thence south west for about 3 3/4 chains along the west side of S. No. 1/1-10 to cairn No. 42 at the theodolite station on the south west corner of that survey number.

South: Thence skirting S. No. 99/3 passing cairn Nos. 43 and 44 to cairn No. 45 at the south west corner of the above S. No., thence skirting survey Nos. 99/1, 98/1, 97/1, 43/1, 43/3, 101/1, 102/1, 125/1 and passing cairn Nos. 46 to 63 to cairn No. 64 at the theodolite station at the north east corner of the last mentioned survey number (a foot path crosses the boundary at cairn No. 59 - cairn Nos. 47, 60, 61, 62, and 63 are at theodolite stations).

West: -Thence skirting S. No. 262/1 passing cairn Nos. 65 to 67 to cairn No. 68 at a theodolite station on the north east corner of that S. No. 262/1 (a stream crosses the boundary between cairn Nos. 65 and 66; cairn Nos. 66 and 67 are at theodolite stations), thence north east for about 2 3/4 chains to cairn No. 69 at a theodolite station on the south side of S. No. 264/2 (a stream and a foot path cross the boundary between cairn Nos. 68 and 69), thence, skirting S. No. 264/2 passing cairn Nos. 70 to 75 to cairn No. 76 at the north west corner of S. No. 264/1, thence north west for about 8 1/2 chains through S. No. 264/2 passing cairn Nos. 77 to 79 to cairn No. 80 on the southern most corner of S. No. 265/3 (a foot path crosses the boundary between cairn Nos. 76 and 77 and another foot path between cairn Nos. 79 and 80), thence east north east for about 2 3/4 chains to cairn No. 81 at a theodolite station on the south east corner of S. No. 265/4 (a foot path crosses the boundary at this cairn), thence north west skirting survey Nos. 265/4, 265/10, 266/1, 2, 3, 7 and 8, 267/4 and 5, passing cairn Nos. 82 to 99 to cairn No. 100 at the north west corner of the last mentioned S. No. (cairn Nos. 84 and 89 are at theodolite stations), thence more or less north for about 8 chains through S. No. 268/1, passing cairn No. 101 to cairn No. 102 (a stream crosses the boundary just north of cairn No. 101), thence north east for about 5 3/4 chains through the above S. No. passing cairn No. 103 to cairn No. 104 at the southernmost corner of S. No. 269/2, thence east for about 3 1/2 chains to cairn No. 105 at the southernmost corner of S. No. 269/1, thence north east skirting S. Nos. 269/1 and 270/3 passing cairn Nos. 106 and 107 to cairn No. 108, thence east south east for about 12 3/4 chains passing cairn Nos. 109 to 112 to cairn No. 113 at a theodolite station on the southern side of S. No. 289/1 (a foot path crosses the boundary at cairn No. 108 and a stream between cairn Nos. 111 and 112), thence in the same direction for about 6 1/4 chains passing cairn No. 114 to cairn No. 115 (from cairn No. 113 to 114 the boundary goes along the south side of S. No. 289/1), thence north for about 2 1/2 chains to cairn No. 116, thence north north east for
