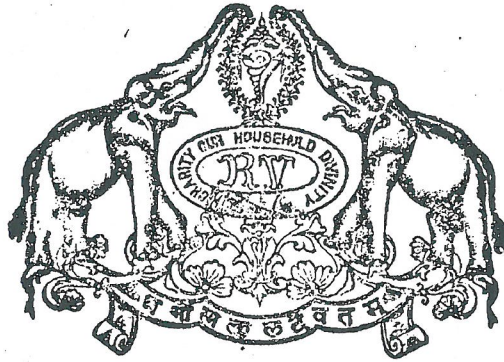

Name of Reserve :	Karayur Sandal Reserve Block No. I.
Name of Revenue Division :	Devicolum.
Name of Taluk :	Devicolum.
Name of Village :	No. 3 Kilanthur and No. 4 Kanthalur (Anjanad Tract).
Extent :	296.30 acres.

**Situation :** The block is situated on the south side of the Pamba river and to the east of Thenkasinathan Koil and comprises a portion of S. Nos. 101/1 and 149/1 of the Kanthalur pakuthy and a portion of S. Nos. 1/1, 11/1, 4/1 and 290/1 of Kilanthur pakuthi, Devicolum taluk.

BOUNDARIES.

**North :** Starting from cairn No. 1 situated about 5 1/2 chains north east of a theodolite station on the north east corner of S. No. 122/1 of Kanthalur pakuthi, the line goes north east for about 2 1/2 chains to cairn No. 2, thence more or less east for about 2 chains to cairn No. 3, thence south east for about 3 3/4 chains passing cairn No. 4 to cairn No. 5, thence more or less south for about 1 1/2 chains to cairn No. 6, thence south east for about 1 1/2 chains crossing the northern boundary of survey No. 149/1 to cairn No. 7, thence south for about 1 3/4 chains to cairn No. 8, thence south east for about 1 chain to cairn No. 9, thence east north east for about 2 1/4 chains to cairn No. 10, thence east for about 1 3/4 chains to cairn No. 11, thence east north east for about 10 chains passing cairn Nos. 12 to 15 to cairn No. 16 about half a chain north west of a theodolite station (village boundary station) at the north east corner of S. No. 149/1 of Kanthalur pakuthi, thence east south east for about 3 chains crossing the northern boundary of S. No. 11/1 of Kilanthur pakuthi and passing cairn No. 17 to cairn No. 18 (the line crosses a stream between cairn Nos. 17 and 18), thence south for about 1 3/4 chains crossing the above boundary to cairn No. 19, thence south east for about 2 chains crossing the above boundary to cairn No. 20, thence south south east for about 1 3/4 chains crossing the above mentioned boundary to cairn No. 21, thence more or less south easterly direction for about 9 3/4 chains passing cairn Nos. 22 to 26 to cairn No. 27 at a theodolite station on the north side of S. No. 11/1 (a foot path from Kottuvallampara to Marayur crosses the boundary at cairn No. 26), thence north along the revenue survey line for about 2 3/4 chains to cairn No. 28 at a theodolite station, thence north north west for about 6 chains to cairn No. 29, thence north east for about 5 chains to cairn No. 30 at the theodolite station on the north side of S. No. 11/1, thence north along the northern boundary of the above survey number for about 2 1/2 chains to cairn No. 31 at the theodolite station on the north east corner of S. No. 11/1, thence north east for about 2 3/4 chains along the western boundary of S. No. 4/1 to cairn No. 32 at the theodolite station on the above boundary, thence east north east for about 3 1/4 chains passing cairn No. 33 to cairn No. 34 at a theodolite station on the western boundary of S. No. 4/1, thence south for about 1 1/4 chains to cairn No. 35, thence east south east for about 2 chains to cairn No. 36, thence east north east for about 2 1/4 chains to cairn No. 37 (the line crosses a stream between cairn Nos. 36 and 37), thence more or less in the same direction for about 8 chains passing cairn Nos. 38 to 40 to cairn No. 41, thence north east for about 7 3/4 chains passing cairn No. 42 and crossing the eastern boundary of S. No. 4/1 to cairn No. 43, thence more or less east for about 1 3/4 chains to cairn No. 44, thence north east for about 12 chains passing cairn Nos. 45 to 47 to cairn No. 48 (the line crosses a stream between cairn Nos. 44 and 45), thence south east for about 3 1/4 chains to cairn No. 49, thence north east for about 2 chains to cairn No. 50, thence east north east for about 6 chains to cairn No. 51.

**East :**—Thence more or less south for about 6 chains passing cairn Nos. 52 and 53 to cairn No. 54, thence south east for about 2 1/4 chains to cairn No. 55, thence east south east for about 2 1/2 chains to cairn No. 56, thence south east for about 6 1/2 chains passing cairn No. 57 to cairn No. 58, thence south south east for about 7 1/4 chains passing cairn Nos. 59 and 60 to cairn No. 61, thence south east for about 5 1/2 chains passing cairn No. 61-A to cairn No. 62 about 1/2 a chain west of the foot path from Chorakulom to Udumalpet.

**South :**—Thence west south west for about 2 chains to cairn No. 63, thence south west for about 7 3/4 chains passing cairn No. 64 to cairn No. 65, thence west south west for about 4 1/4 chains to cairn No. 66, thence west north west for about 3 1/2 chains to cairn No. 67, thence south west for about 3 chains to cairn No. 68, thence south south west for about





1-1/2 chains to cairn No. 69, thence south west for about 18 1/4 chains passing cairn Nos. 70 to 74 to cairn No. 75 about 1 1/4 chains east of the northern most corner of S. No. 5/2 of Kilanthur Pakuthi, thence west north west for about 3 1/2 chains to cairn No. 76 crossing the western boundary of S. No. 290/1, thence west south west for about 5 chains to cairn No. 77, thence north west for about 8 1/2 chains passing cairn Nos. 78 and 79 to cairn No. 80 at a theodolite station on the north east corner of S. No. 6/1, thence west south west for about 2 chains to cairn No. 81 at the northern boundary of S. No. 9/1 (a stream crosses the boundary between cairn Nos. 80 and 81), thence west along the above boundary for about 3/4 of a chain to cairn No. 82 at the north west corner of S. No. 9/1, thence west north west for about 2 1/2 chains to cairn No. 83, thence west south west for about 1 3/4 chains to cairn No. 84, thence south west for about 3 3/4 chains to cairn No. 85 at the north west corner of S. No. 10/3 (a foot path from Kottuvallampara to Marayur crosses the boundary at cairn No. 85), thence more or less in the same direction along the western side of S. No. 10/3 for about 4 1/2 chains passing cairn Nos. 86 and 87 to cairn No. 88 at the south west corner of the above survey number, thence south south east for about 2 chains to cairn No. 89, thence south east for about 5 1/4 chains passing cairn No. 90 to cairn No. 91, thence east north east for about 3 1/4 chains passing cairn No. 92 to cairn No. 93 at the south east corner of S. No. 9/1, thence south east along the southern side of S. Nos. 8/1 and 8/2 for about 1 1/2 chains to cairn No. 94 at the theodolite station on the south east corner of the latter survey number, thence north east along the eastern side of S. No. 8/2 for about 8/4 of a chain to cairn No. 95, thence south east for about 2 chains to cairn No. 96, thence south south east for about 3 1/2 chains to cairn No. 97, thence east south east for about 1 1/3 chains to cairn No. 98, thence south west for about 5 1/4 chains passing cairn No. 99 to cairn No. 100 at the northern most corner of S. No. 164/2, thence in the same direction along the northern side of S. No. 164/2 for about 1 3/4 chains to cairn No. 101 at the north west corner of the above survey number, thence south east along the western sides of S. Nos. 164/2 and 164/1 for about 7 1/4 chains passing cairn Nos. 102 to 104 to cairn No. 105 situated on the west side of S. No. 164/1 (cairn No. 104 is at a theodolite station), thence south south east for about 1 1/2 chains to cairn No. 106 (a stream crosses the boundary between cairn Nos. 105 and 106), thence south south west for about 4 chains passing cairn No. 107 to cairn No. 108 at the theodolite station on the north side of S. No. 161/3, thence west south west for about 1 1/2 chains to cairn No. 109, thence south for about 1 1/2 chains to cairn No. 110, thence south west for about 1 3/4 chains to cairn No. 111 on the north west corner of S. No. 160/3, thence south south west for about 3 chains to cairn No. 112, thence south west for about 2 chains to cairn No. 113 on the north west corner of S. No. 160/1, thence in the same direction for about 2 1/2 chains to cairn No. 114 at the theodolite station on the north side of S. No. 158/2, thence more or less west for about 4 1/4 chains to cairn No. 115, thence west south west for about 3 1/4 chains to cairn No. 116, thence south west for about 10 1/2 chains passing cairn Nos. 117 to 119 to cairn No. 120 (Kanakayam odai crosses the boundary between cairn Nos. 118 and 119), thence west north west for about 5 1/4 chains crossing the village boundary between Kilanthur and Kanthalur to cairn No. 121 at about 1 1/2 chains north west of a theodolite station (village boundary station) on the above boundary.

West :- Thence north north west for about 24 3/4 chains passing cairn Nos. 122 to 129 to cairn No. 130 (4 streams cross the boundary between cairn Nos. 124 and 125, 125 and 126, and 127 and 128), thence north west for about 2 chains to cairn No. 131, thence north for about 2 3/4 chains passing cairn No. 132 to cairn No. 133, thence north west for about 1 1/2 chains to cairn No. 134 at the north east corner of S. No. 128/3, thence north north west for about 4 chains passing cairn No. 135 to cairn No. 136, thence north west for about 2 chains to cairn No. 137 at the north east corner of S. No. 126/1, thence north west for about 7 1/2 chains passing cairn Nos. 138 to cairn No. 140 to cairn No. 141, thence more or less in the same direction for about 3 chains to cairn No. 142 at a theodolite station on the north east corner of S. No. 124/1, thence north west along the east side of S. No. 123/3 for about 2 1/4 chains to cairn No. 143 at the north east corner of the above survey number, thence west north west for about 2 1/2 chains to cairn No. 144, thence north west for about 2 chains to cairn No. 145 at a theodolite station on the east side of S. No. 123/1, thence in the same direction along the east side of S. No. 123/1 for about 2 chains to cairn No. 146 at the north east corner of the above survey number, thence north along the east side of S. No. 122/3 for about 2 chains to cairn No. 147 at the north east corner of the above survey number, thence more or less north west for about 5 3/4 chains passing cairn No. 148 to cairn No. 149 at a theodolite station on the north side of S. No. 149/1, thence in the same direction for about 3 3/4 chains passing cairn No. 150 to cairn No. 1 at the starting point on the north boundary.

ADMITTED PUBLIC RIGHT WITHIN THE RESERVE FOR MEN AND CATTLE.

A foot path from Kottuvallampara, five feet wide, goes along the outside of the southern boundary of the reserve from cairn No. 110 to cairn No. 85, enters the reserve and leaves the reserve at cairn No. 26 on the northern boundary and goes along the outside of the northern boundary near to cairn No. 1 and thence to Marayur. The length of the foot path within the reserve is about 3 1/2 chains.
