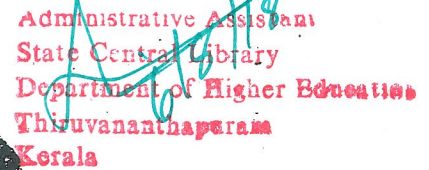

Name of Reserve :—Natchivayal Sandalwood Reserve Block No. II.

Name of Revenue Division :—Devicolam.

Name of Taluk :—Devicolam.

Name of Villages :—No. 1 Natchivayal and No. 2 Marayur.

Extent :—250 acres.

Situation :—The block is situated to the west of the Northern Outlet road (about the 23rd and 25th mile stones) which forms the western boundary of Natchivayal Sandalwood Reserve Block I and comprises the whole of survey numbers 29/1/1, 29/1/5, 29/1/7, 29/1/15, 29/1/16 and 29/1/18 of Natchivayal Pakuthi and a portion of S. No. 238/1 of Marayur Pakuthi, Devicolam Taluk.

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION.

North :—Starting from cairn No. 1 situated on the right bank of the Kaniyankadavu Aur about 4 1/2 chains west of the theodolite stone on the south-west corner of survey number 199/1 of Marayur pakuthy, the line goes south-east for about 12 1/2 chains along the right bank of the Kaniyankadavu Aur to cairn No. 2 on the same bank of the Aur about 2 1/4 chains north-east of the northern most corner of survey number 10/2.

East :—Thence more or less south-west for about 2 1/4 chains and crossing the Meladuvayal Channel between cairn Nos. 2 and 3 to cairn No. 3 at the northern most corner of survey number 10/2, thence south-west along the west side of the above survey number for about 4 1/2 chains passing cairn No. 4 to cairn No. 5 at the south-west corner of the same survey number, thence in the same direction for about 2 3/4 chains along the west side of the Northern Outlet road (the western boundaries of survey numbers 10/1 and 9/1) to cairn No. 5 A, at the south-west corner of survey number 9/1 and opposite to the 25th mile stone, thence southward for about 119 3/4 chains along the western side of the said road to cairn No. 6 at the north-east corner of survey number 29/1/2, thence west south-west for about 7 1/4 chains along the north side of the above survey number to cairn No. 7 on the north-west corner of that survey number, thence south-east for about 10 chains along the west sides of survey numbers 29/1/2 and 29/1/10 to cairn No. 8 on the southernmost corner of the latter survey number, thence north north-east for about 9 1/4 chains along the south side of survey number 29/1/10 to cairn No. 9 at its south-east corner and on the west side of the Northern Outlet road, thence more or less southward again along the said road for about 46 1/4 chains to cairn No. 10 at a theodolite station on the north-east corner of survey number 16/1.

South :—Thence more or less westward for about 23 1/4 chains along the northern sides of survey numbers 16/1 and 17/1 passing cairn Nos. 11 to 16 to cairn No. 17 on the south-west corner of survey number 29/1/16.

West :—Thence north north-east for about 8 3/4 chains along the east side of survey number 29/1/11 to cairn No. 18 at its north east corner, thence west north-west for about 10 1/4 chains along the north side of the above survey number to cairn No. 19 on the Kandam line, 213 links north of the theodolite stone on the western boundary of survey number 29/1/11, thence more or less northward along the Kandam line for about 108 chains passing cairn Nos. 20 to 50 to cairn No. 51 at a village boundary stone on the northern most corner of survey number 29/1/5, thence north north-east for about 5 1/2 chains passing cairn No. 52 to cairn No. 53, thence north-west for about 5 chains to cairn No. 54, thence west for about 2 3/4 chains to cairn No. 55, thence north north-east for about 15 1/2 chains passing cairn Nos. 56 and 57 to cairn No. 58, thence north-east for about 3 1/2 chains to cairn No. 59, thence east north-east for about 3 chains to cairn No. 60, thence north east for about 14 chains passing cairn Nos. 61 and 62 to cairn No. 63, thence north north-east for about 5 1/2 chains passing cairn Nos. 64 and 65 to cairn No. 1 the starting point on the north boundary.

ADMITTED PUBLIC RIGHTS WITHIN THE RESERVE FOR MEN AND CATTLE.

A footpath 5 feet wide commencing from the northern outlet road and going to the Chandrakumaran Koil. The length of the footpath is about 16.50 chains.

Description :—The above footpath enters the reserve (survey number 29/1/15) at or near the 24th mile 2nd furlong in the northern outlet road and goes more or less in a westerly direction for about 16 1/2 chains and leaves the reserve between cairn Nos. 43 and 44 on the western boundary.

THE RIGHTS FOR TAKING WATER THROUGH THE FOLLOWING CHANNELS ARE ALSO ADMITTED WITHIN THE RESERVE.

1. A water channel (Alathur Vaikal) 5 feet broad enters the reserve between cairn Nos. 64 and 65 on the western boundary and flowing into the Ooruvasal Vayal. The length of the Water channel is about 78 chains.

Description :—The water channel (Alathur Vaikal) enters the reserve at a point about 68 links north of a cairn No. 64 and flows more or less in a southerly direction for about 78 chains





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*Description*.—The water channel (Meladivayal Vaikal) enters the reserve at a point about 4 1/4 chains south-east of cairn No. 1 of the reserve on the right bank of Kaniyankadavu Aur and flows in a south easterly direction for about 7 chains and leaves the reserve near cairn No. 3 on the eastern boundary.
