Situation.—The block is situated on the southern side of the Vannanthora river and to the east of Survey number 1/1/6 of the Kilanthur Pakuthy known as Melaperumkadavu and forms a portion of Survey No. 1/1 of the same Pakuthy.

### BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION.

North.—Starting from cairn No. 1 at the theodolite stone on the southern boundary of Survey No. 1/1/6 of Kilanthur Pakuthy, the line goes east for about 3 chains along the southern boundary of that Survey number to cairn No. 2 a traverse station on the south-east corner of the above survey number, thence north-east for about 3 chains to cairn No. 3 at a theodolite stone on the north-eastern corner of the above survey number where it meets the Vannanthora stream, thence more or less south-east along the left hank of the same stream for about 73 1/2 chains to cairn No. 4 at the north-east corner of the block.

East.—Thence south south-east for about 18 1/2 chains passing cairn numbers 5 to 9 to cairn No. 10 on the foot path from Kilanthur to Ollavayal, thence west for about 1 1/4 chains to cairn No. 11, thence south-west for about 16 1/4 chains passing cairn Nos. 12 to 16 and crossing a stream between cairn Nos. 16 and 17 to cairn No. 17, thence south-west for about 1 chains to cairn No. 18.

South.—Thence west for about 4 chains passing cairn No. 19 and crossing two streams to cairn No. 20, thence north-west for about 7 chains passing cairn Nos. 21 and 22 to ourn No. 23, thence west north-west for about 2 chains to cairn No. 24, thence west south-west for about 4 1/4 chains to cairn No. 25, thence west for about 5 chains and crossing a small stream to cairn No. 26, thence west south-west for about 5 chains to cairn No. 27 on the foot path from Kilanthur, to Ollavayal, thence west for about 2 1/3 chains to cairn No. 28.

(N. ts: The Reserve boundary from cairn Nos. 10 to 27 follows the foot path from Ollavayal to Kilanthur).

West.—Thence north-west for about 12 chains passing cairn Nos. 29 to 32 to cairn No. 33, thence in the same direction but slightly west for about 2 1/2 chains crossing the foot path from Kilanthur to Palapatti to cairn No. 34, thence north-west for about 11 1/4 chains pissing cairn Nos. 35 and 36 to cairn No. 37, thence west north-west for about 9 1/2 chains passing cairn Nos. 28 and 39 to cairn No 40, thence north-west for about 3 1/4 chains to cairn No. 41, thence in the same direction but slightly to the north for about 3 1/4 chains to cairn No. 42, thence north-west for about 14 chains passing cairn Nos. 43 and 44 to cairn No. 45, thence north northwest for about 5 3/4 chains to cairn No. 46, thence north north-east for about 2 1 4 chains to cairn No. 47, thence in the same direction slightly east for about 11 chains passing cairn Nos. 48 and 49 to cairn No. 50, thence north-east for about 2 1/2 chains to cairn No. 1 at the starting point on the northern boundary.

ADMITTED PUBLIC RIGHTS WITHIN THE RESERVE FOR MEN AND CATTLE.

(1) A foot path 5 feet wide enters the reserve between cairn Nos. 33 and 34 from Kilanthur to Palapatty passing almost through the centre of the reserve for a distance of about 46 chains.

Description.—The above foot-path enters the reserve at a point about 231 links north-west of a cairn No. 33 on the western boundary and goes in a more or less northerly direction almost through the centre of the Reserve for about 46 chains and crosses the Vannanthora river on the northern boundary.

(2) The rights of grazing are limited to cows and bulls alone (not to sheep and goats) to the Villagers of Karayur and Vannanthora. If this concession is abused or if the grazing is found harmful to the Reserve, the concession will be stopped or with-drawn.
