

Annex.No.2 Mount Plateau

50 sq.miles Reserved; 13 sq miles Unreserved

NOTIFICATION

No. F1-2854/49/DD.

11th August 1950.

It is hereby notified that the area known as "Mount Plateau" falling within the boundaries specified below is declared a Game Sanctuary and that this sanctuary called hereinafter 'Annex No. 2 to the Wild Life Sanctuary' is permanently closed under sections 21 and 22 of the Travancore Forest Act II of 1068 as continued in force by the U.S.T.C. Administration and application of Laws Act 1125 (VI of 1125) against all shooting, hunting, felling and cutting down of timber, collection of forest produce, grazing of cattle and all trespass except under and with the specific orders of Government.

Name - Annex No. 2 to the wildlife sanctuary (Mount Plateau)
Revenue Division - Quilon and Kottayam
Taluks - Pathanamthitta and Peerumedu
Extent - 63 square miles (163.17 sq.km)

West and North: - Starting from a point on the northern boundary of Pathanamthitta Taluk situated at the confluence of Pamba and Azhutha Rivers, the boundary follows the northern boundary of Pathanamthitta Taluk till it meets the Sabarimala Thodu thence eastward along the left bank of the stream at the foot of Sabarimala Plateau till it meets the northern boundary of Pathanamthitta Taluk, thence the above Taluk boundary till it meets the western boundary of Periyar Lake Reserve Forest to the south of the Periyar Dam.

East: Thence the boundary follows the western boundary of Periyar Lake Reserve Forest up to Uppuparai, thence along the southern boundary of the same reserve up to Karuvattuparamalai

South: Thence the boundary runs in a straight line joining the Kallar river (locally known as Kullar) at the proposed dam site, thence along the right banks of Kallar and Pamba rivers up to the starting point.
