

# **THIRUNELLY RESERVE FOREST**

**Extent : 5077.91 Acres**

**Madras Forest Act- Tirunelli Reserved  
Forest -Limits redefiend**

**No.585**

Whereas the Tirunelli, Woodstock and Tirunelli additions I to III Reserved Forests have been amalgamated in to a single reserved forest known as the Tirunelli Reserved Forest;

And whereas the description of the limits of the Tirunelli Reserved Forest, as amalgamated, is not clear in reference to existing facts;

Now, therefore in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (4) of section 17-A of the Madras Forest Act, 1882 (Madras Act V of 1882) and in Excellency the Governor of Madras is hereby pleased to redefine the limits of the Tirunelli Reserved Forest so as to make the description clear in reference to existing facts by making the following correction to the limits of the said forest:-

For the schedule tot he Revenue Department Notification No.559, dated the 24th November 1892, published at page 1527 of part I of the Fort ST.George Gazette , dated the 6th December 1892, the following schedule shall be substituted , namely:-

**SCHEDULE**

**Malabar district, Wynad Taluk, Tirunelli amsom, Tirunelli desam  
[Name of forest- Tirunelli Reserved Forest, Area in acres - 5.077.91**

**North:-** Starting from the trijunction of Wynad Taluk, Kottayam taluk and Coorg territory, the boundary line runs eastwards along the Malabar-Coorg boundary till it meets the westernmost corner of survey No.88 of Tirunelli desam, thence the line runs along the east and south sides of survey No.81 to the northern most point of survey No.79, thence along its west and south sides, side of Survey No. 78 and west side of survey No.82 to its south-west corner; thence along the south sides of survey No. 82 to its south-west corner; thence along the south sides of survey Nos. 62, 77 and 86 to the westernmost corner of survey No.229; thence along the west sides of survey No.229, west and south sides of Survey No.230, west sides of survey No. 227, west and south sides of survey No.231, south and east sides of survey No.224 and the south sides of survey Nos 223, 222, 220 and 219 to the north-west corner of survey No.211; thence along the west, south, and east (part) sides of survey No.211 and the west, south and east sides of survey No.209 to the westernmost corner of survey No.206; thence along the west (part) side of survey No.206, north, west and south sides of survey No.208 and the west and south sides of survey No.207 to the southernmost corner of the last mentioned field; thence due south along the west side of survey No.400 (Kudrakotte reserved Forest) to the north-east corner of survey No. 370; thence along the north and west sides of survey No.379 to the northernmost corner of survey No.380; thence along the north and west sides of survey Nos 380 and 384 north side of Survey No.388, east- north and west sides of survey No 389, North sides of survey Nos 390 and 391. East and north sides of survey No.392 east, north and west sides of survey No.393 and the north, west, south and east (part) sides of survey No.394 to the southernmost corner of survey No.393 (Trifurcation of survey Nos.393, 394 and 392), thence along the south sides of survey No.392 and the west and south sides of survey No.391 until it meets the Trifurcation of survey No.391, 399/1 and 399/3 where it meets the Bavali River.

**South:-** Thence the line runs westwards along the north side of survey No.399/3 till it meets the northernmost corner of survey No.356; thence along the north and west sides of SurveyNo.356, north, west and south sides of survey no.355 west side of survey No.356 again and the north sides of Survey No.399/3 again till it meets the east side of survey No.341; thence along the east and north sides of survey No.340, north aide of 341 again and the north side of that portion of survey No.332 which lies between survey Nos 339 and 341 to the north-east corner of survey No.339; thence along the north sides of survey No.339, east side of survey No.338, north-east sides of survey Nos 337 and 336 to the northern most corner of the last mentioned field; thence along the east and north sides of survey No.334, north side of survey no.332 which lies between survey Nos. 334 and 247, and the north sides of survey Nio.241 till it meets the south-east corner of survey No.240; thence along the east side of survey No.240 and the north sides of survey No.241 again to the easternmost corner of survey No.239, thence along the north and west aides of survey No.239 to its westernmost corner; thence along the east sides of survey No.253, east and north sides of survey No. 238, and the north sides of survey Nos 261, 262 and 263 to the north-west corner of the last mentioned field, thence along the east side of survey No. 271, east and north sides of survey No.269 and the north sides of survey Nos. 270, 271 and 273 to the south-east corner of survey No.276 (trijunction of survey Nos 273, 275 and 276; thence along the east side of survey No.276) and the east and north sides of survey No.277 to the easternmost corner of survey No.74 crossing the Tirunelli Road (subdivision No.14); thence along the east side of survey no.74, north side of survey No.75 and east side of survey No.69, and the south, east and north sides of survey No.68 to the north-east corner of survey No.55; thence along the east sides of survey No 55, 54 and 53 east and north sides of survey No. 49, and the north sides of survey Nos.50 and 44/2 to the south-east corner of survey No. 44/3; thence along the east, north and west sides of that number to its south-west corner; thence along the north side of survey No.44/2 again, west sides of survey No48, north sides of survey Nos.47/2 and 293 and the north and west sides of survey No.295 till it meets the northernmost corner of survey No.296;

thence along the north-west side of survey No.296 (crossing the Bavali river to the trijunction of survey Nos. 44/1, 296 and 297) and thence along the north side of survey No.297 (Hilldale reserved forest) till it meets the Kottayam taluk boundary.

**West** :- Thence the line runs along the eastern boundary of the said taluk boundary to the starting point.

The Tirunelli reserve comprises the whole of S.Nos 3 to 9, 15 to 42 and 43 (part) forming the Tirunelli district road portion and S.Nos. 44/1, 45, 46, 47/1, 87, 237, 294, 397, 398, 399/1 and 399/2 of Tirunelli amsam and desam

(2) The following rights of way are admitted in this reserve:-

(i) A road (Tiruvelli Road) is open to people, cattle and carts. It is 10 yards wide and 4 miles 4 furlongs in length. It enters the reserve at the south-east corner of S.No.74 and runs generally in an easterly direction and leaves the reserve at a point 2 chains south from the south-east corner of S.No.207

(ii) A path (for which there is no local name) is open to people and cattle only. It is 10 yards wide and 1 mile 3 furlongs in length. It enters the reserve at a point 10 chain east of the north-western corner of S.No.44/2 and runs generally in a northerly direction and leaves the reserve at the Brahmagiri peak on the Coorg frontier.

(iii) A path (for which there is no local name) is open to people and cattle only. It is 10 yards wide and 14 chains long. It enters the reserve at the north-western corner of S.No.394 and runs, generally in a westerly direction to north-eastern corner of S.No.396 which is an enclosure within the reserve.

(iv) A path (for which there is no local name) is open to people and cattle only. It is 10 yards wide and 28 chains in length. It enters the reserve on the south-eastern corner of S.No.341 and runs in an easterly direction and leaves the reserve at the south-west corner of S.No.355.

(3) The Jains and Bet kurumbers residing in this block are permitted to continue to enjoy their present privileges as tenants- at- will of the Forest department.
