No. 320:- His Excellency the Governor in Council is pleased to declare under the provisions of section 16 of) The Madras Forest Act (V of 1882) that, from the 1st September 1900, the area, the boundaries of which are set forth in the schedule appended to this notification, shall be constituted a 'reserved forest'.

Boundaries

North.-Starting from a point on the right bank of the Kabani river due south of the northern end of the Kuruva Island (reserve forest, the boundary of the reserve runs in a straight line, touching the extreme western point of survey No. 296, to the westernmost point of survey No. 94, thence passing along one distance on the north side of survey No. 95-A, and across survey No. 95, it proceeds to the western extremity of the north side of survey No. 96, then passes .along its west and south sides to south-west corner, thence to the westernmost point of survey No. 99 then passes south along the west side of that number to its southernmost point on the left bank of mundantod (stream) , thence following that bank southward to the point at which the west side of survey No. 100-A, crosses it, then along the west and the south sides of that number backs to the

left bank of the same stream, along which *it* continues to a point slightly east of north of the northernmost point of survey No. 102, thence to the said point, then along the north and west sides of that number to its southernmost point; thence it strikes across to the northern extremity of the south-west side of the survey No. 101, then south-east along this side for a distance of not more than thirty-five yards; thence to the south-west corner of survey No. 104 thence in a straight line to the northern extremity of westernmost side of survey No. 138; passing along the side if continues along the south-west side of survey No. 134 to the southernmost point of the last mentioned number; thence eastward to the western corner of the southern side of survey No. 133; it passes along this side to its eastern extremity; thence to the south-west corner of survey No. 132; then the south side of that number to its south-east corner and thence in a straight line due east to the right bank of the Mundantod; thence continuing along the bank of the stream south-eastward along the south sides of survey Nos. 128 and 129 till where that bank leaves the side of the latter number; thence continuing along that side until it meets the southernmost point of survey No. 131; then along the east and north sides of survey No. 131, north side of Nos. 130 and 129, and the east and north sides of No. 128, back to the right bank of the Mundantod; thence the stream bank northward to the southernmost point of survey No. 127, thence along the east and north side of Sy. No. 127, the east, north and west sides of Sy. No. 126 and again the north side of survey No. 127 westward back to the right bank of the stream; thence the right bank of the stream north-west until it meets the east side of survey No. 101, thence the east and north sides of survey No. 101 to its northernmost point; thence in a straight line north-west to the southern extremity of the east side survey No. 100, then northward along the east side of the last mentioned number to its north-eastern extremity; thence north north-west to the easternmost point of survey No. 94, thence north, north-east to the western extremity of the southern side of survey No. 88, thence eastward along that side to the southern extremity of the westernmost side of survey No. 81; then the west side of that number to its southernmost corner; thence a straight line to the southernmost point of survey No. 66, thence to the south-west corner of survey No. 65; then along the south and east sides of that number the south and east sides of survey No. 61 to its northernmost point; then the east side of survey No. 60 to the south-east corner of survey No. 59; thence in a straight line to the southernmost point of survey No. 56, thence north-east the south side of that number to the eastern extremity of the southern side; thence to the southernmost point of survey No. 55; then its east side to its easternmost point; thence to the stone marking as a bent angle midway in the south side of survey No. 48; thence east north-east to the south-west corner of survey No. 42; then along its south-west and south-east sides to the south side of survey No. 40; thence along the south, east and north sides of the last mentioned

number to the south-east corner of survey No. 39; thence the east and north sides of survey No. 39; to its north-west corner; thence in a straight line to the northernmost point of survey No. 46 on the right bank of the Kabani river; thence the river bank northwards to where the boundary between the Pakanthore and Pilpalli desoms turns south from it; thence the boundary-between: these two desoms south-eastward and then eastward for a total distance of nearly three miles.

East.- Thence turning southwards it passes along- the boundary of the Pillpalli and Pakanthore desoms -for nearly one mile to the point at which the north side of. survey No. 290, joins that boundary, thence along the east and north Sides of that number to its northernmost corner; thence west by south three (furlongs to the northernmost point of survey No. 292; thence south-westward along the north-west side of that' survey number to -its westernmost point, thence south along the south west side of that number to its south-west corner; thence east south-east to the south-west corner of survey No. 293; eastward along the south side of the number to its south-east corner and thence in the same direction to the south-west corner of survey No. 283, thence eastward along the south side of that number to its south-east corner which *is* on the boundary between the two aforesaid desoms, thence southwards along the desom boundary to a point thereon due east of the north-east corner of survey No. 287; thence westward to the north-east corner of that number; thence west along its north side; south along its west side and east along its south side to its south-east corner; thence due east back to the desom boundary; thence southwest along the desom boundary to the northernmost point of survey No. 285; thence southward along the north west side of survey No. 285 to its south-west corner thence westward along the north side or survey No. 283 to its north west corner thence westward along the north *side* of survey No. 282; southward along *its* west side and eastward along its south side to its south-east corner which *is* .also the south west corner of survey No. 283; thence south east-ward along the south west aide of the last mentioned number to its southernmost point on the boundary between the above mentioned desoms; then again that boundary south westward to the point at *which* the north side of survey No. 276 joins it; thence westward along the north side.. _ of survey No. 276 to the south-east corner of survey No. 273; thence northward along the east, westward along the north ,and south ward along the west sides of that ~umber to its south west corner on the north side, of survey No. 270 thence agall1 westward along the north side of survey No. 276 to the southernmost corner of survey' No. 272; thence northward along the east side of that number and north westward along its north east side to its northernmost point; thence in the same direction along the north-east side of survey No. 271 to its northernmost point; thence southwest ward along its north-west side to where that side meets the north east side of survey

No. 270; thence north westward along the north-east side of the latter number, westward along *its* north side and thence southward and westward along its west side to the north-west corner of the south western arm of that number; thence west south-west to the north-east corner of survey No. 269 and in the same direction along the north side of the latter number; south along its west side and east along its south side to its south-east corner; thence eastward to the south-west corner of the south western arm of survey No. 270, thence in a generally south easterly direction along the southwest side of that number to the north west corner of survey No. 280 thence south westward along the north-west side of the latter number to its south-west corner; thence along the west side of the survey No. 274 to the southwest corner of that number; thence eastward along the south side of survey No. 274 to its south-east corner; thence east south-east to the north-west corner of survey No. 279, thence southward along the west side of the last mentioned number to its south-west corner; thence southwest ward nearly two furlongs to the northwest corner of the westward extension of the southern portion of survey No. 276; thence southward along the west side of survey No. 276 to the south-west corner of the same number; thence south southeast to the south west corner of the same number; thence south west to the north-east corner of survey No. 225; thence westward along the north side of that number to its north west corner and southward along its west side to the north east corner of survey No. 223; thence westward along the north side of the last mentioned number for three stones to the north-east corner of the northern arm of that survey number; thence north by west to the southernmost point of survey No. 227; thence along the east and north -sides of that number first north and then westward to its north western corner where it joins the north side of survey No. 228; thence the north east side of the latter number to where it meets the north side of survey No. 229; thence along the north side of the last mentioned number to its northernmost point thence t. a straight line to the north east corner of survey No. 259, thence the boundary turns northward to three and a half furlongs to the southern end of the east side of survey No. 281 and continues northward along the east side of that number to its north east corner then westward along its north side to its north west corner and southward along its west side to its south west corner; then in a straight line south westward three furlongs to the north east corner of survey No. 256; and then westward along the north side of that number to its north west corner then southward along its west side to *its* south west corner; thence south westward to eastern end and of the northernmost side of survey No. 252; then westward along the north side of that number and of the northernmost side of survey No. 252; then westward along the north side of that number and of No. 253 to the Northwest corner of the latter number; then southward along its west side to the south west corner thereof which is also the northwest corner of survey No. 251, then south southeast along the west side of

the latter number to its south west corner, then southward along the west side of survey No. 249 to the north west side of survey No. 246 thence south westward along that side to the north east corner of survey No. 245, thence westward along the north side of that number to the northernmost point of survey No. 239; thence southward along the west side of that number to the northwest corner of survey No. 238; then southward along the west and east southeast along the south sides of survey No. 238 to its southernmost point; thence east south eastward to the westernmost point of survey No. 237; then south eastward along the south west and north eastward along the south east sides of that number to its easternmost point; thence in the same direction i.e. north eastward across survey No. 254 to the left bank of the Mundantod; thence south-eastward along the same bank of that stream to the point at which the west side of survey No. 223, crosses it; then along the west and south side of survey • No. 223 back to the same bank of the stream and thence up the stream to the point where it enters the Vellyambam Desom thence south southward along the boundary between Vellyambam and Pakanthore desoms to the northernmost point of survey No. 218; Then the boundary passes south westward along the north west side of survey No. 218 to its westernmost point; thence in the same direction to the north east corner of survey No. 216 (all the above survey numbers are of Pakanthore desom) and then westward along the north and southward along the west sides of that number to its southernmost point; thence south south eastward crossing the boundary between Pakanthore and Vellyambam desoms to the westernmost point of survey No. 12 of Vellyambam desom; thence in the same direction along the southwest and southeast sides of that number to the southwest corner of survey No. 13 A; thence; eastward along the south side of survey No. 13 A and 13 to the south side of survey No.9. thence eastward that Side to Its southeast corner and then along the south Side of survey No.8 to the point at which that Side IS crossed by the Mundantod; thence it turns south and goes to the northwest corner of survey No. 36; then the west, south and east sides of this number and on from its north corner in a straight line to the Mundantod then up that stream east southeast to the westernmost point of survey No. 38 and along the south side of that number eastward to the northernmost point of survey No. 44, then down the west side of that number to the northernmost point of survey No. 45 and along the north; west and south sides of that number back to the west side of survey No. 44, southward along the west side of survey No. 44 which lies between survey No. 45 to and 47 to the north side of the latter number; then along its north; west and south sides back to the west side of survey No. 44; and thence its west south and east sides to the southwest corner of survey No. 43, thence its south and east sides to its easternmost corner; thence nearly due-south to the northernmost point of survey No. 56; then turning west along the north side of that number to the north east corner of survey No. 55, then

along the north side of that number to its north west-corner; thence south-west to the north-east corner of survey No. 49; thence along the north side of that number to its north west corner; thence in a straight lines to the northernmost point of survey No. 50 thence along the north and west sides of that number and the west and south sides of survey No. 50A to where it meets west side of survey No. 53, thence the west side of that number to its south-west corner; thence on in a straight line to the northernmost point of survey No. 135; thence along its north, west and east sides to its south-east corner the thence eastward in a straight line to the north-west corner of survey No. 78, then along its west and south sides to the south-east corner and thence in a straight line to the southeast corner of survey No. 85, thence to the south-west corner of survey No. 66; then eastward along the south side of that number to its south east corner and on to the southernmost point of survey No. 88, thence southward along the west side of survey No. 87 to its south west corner, thence a straight line to the northwest corner of No. 86, then along the west, south and east sides of survey No 86 to its north east corner, then a straight line to the south east corner of No. 87, then the east side of survey No. 87 to about midway on that side, thence east to the boundary between Vellayambam and Pilpalli desoms at a point nearly two furlongs south of the southern extremity of survey ~o. 95, thence southward along that boundary to the trijunction between Pilpalli Vellyambam and Pudadi desoms; then southwest ward along the boundary of the latter two desoms to a point thereon due east of the northeast corner of survey No. 97; thence a straight line to that corner; thence westward along the north side of survey No. 97 until it meets the south West corner of survey No. 96, then the south, east and north sides of that number back to the north side of survey No. 97 again; then along its north and west sides to the northernmost corner of survey No. 98; then along its north and west sides to the west side of survey No. 97, again and on south-west ward along that side to the northeast corner of survey No. 101; then westward along the north side of that number to the south corner of survey No. 102, thence round the east, north and west sides of the latter number back to the north side of survey No. 101; then westward along that side to its northwest corner; thence along the north side of survey No. 105 to the south east corner of survey No. 103, thence the east, north and west sides of that number back to the north side of survey No. 105, thence that side to the southwest corner of No. 104-, thence along the south; east and north sides of that No. to the north side of survey No. 105 again; thence. along the north and west sides of the last mentioned number to the northernmost corner of survey No. 106, then the west and south sides of survey No. 106 to its southeast corner where it meets the South side of survey No. 105; then along the south side of that number to where it meets the southwest corner of survey No. 101 on eastward along the south side of survey No. 101 to the north west corner of survey No. 100; then the west, south and

southeast sides of survey No. 100 back to the south side of survey' No. 101; then eastward along that side to the south west corner of survey No. 97, then along the south side of that number to the north west corner of survey No. 99; then along the west and south sides of survey No. 99 back to the south side of survey No. 97 and then eastward along that side to its southeast corner; thence the boundary continues eastward to the boundary between Vellyambam and Pudadi desoms; it then follows the desom boundary south-westward to a point thereon due east of the northernmost point of survey No. 108, thence it turns due west to the northernmost point of survey number last mentioned and .; then down the north and west sides of that number and No. 108 A back to the desom boundary, which it then follows southwestward to the right bank of the Nirdi poya at the south-eastern corner of Kalamangalam Kunnu.

South.- The boundary then passes westward along the right or north bank of this Poya (river) to the south-east corner of survey No. 117, it then turns northward along the east and westward along the north side of that number to the north-east corner of survey No. 119 and thence along the north and west sides of survey No. 119 and the west sides of survey No. 118 to the south-west corner of the latter number; then the west side of survey No. 117 to the right bank of the Niridi poya; thence down that stream in a generally north-westerly direction to the south-east corner of survey No. 145: thence northward along the east side of that number to where it meets the south-east side of survey No. 144, thence that side, the east and north sides of survey No. 141 to the western extremity of its northernmost side and thence in a straight line to the easternmost corner of survey No 151; thence the east side of survey No. 151: to the south west corner of survey No. 152; thence along the south; east and north sides of the last mentioned number back to the east side of survey No. 151; and then northward and south-westward along its east and north sides to the easternmost point of survey No. 153; then along the east, north; and west sides of that number back to the west side of survey No. 151 along which it continues southward to where it meets the north side of survey No. 154; thence along the north, west and south sides of that number till it meets the west side of survey No. 155; thence southward along that side to the northernmost corner of survey No. 156; then along the west sides of survey No. 156 until it meets the west side of survey No. 157; then southward along the west sides of survey Nos. 157 and 157 A to the eastside of survey No. 158; thence along the east, north and west sides of the last number back to the west side of survey No. 157-A, thence westward along that side to the boundary between Vellyambam .and Kuppattod desoms (all the above numbers are of Vellyambam desom) thence southeast ward along that boundary back to the right bank of Nircli poya; thence that stream westward to a point on the right bank thereof due south of the easternmost extremity or survey No. 376 of Kuppattod desom, thence northward to the eastern

extremity of that number; then westward along the north sides of survey Nos. 376, 375 and 374 to the northwest corner of the last mentioned number, thence the boundary turns north northwestwards to the easternmost point of survey No. 373; then along the northeast side of the last mentioned number to its northernmost point and then in a straight line to the south east corner of survey No. 369, then along the east, north and west sides of that number to its south west corner and thence to the survey stone southeast of that at the northern extremity of survey No. 377; thence on to the northern extremity of survey No. 377 and thence in a straight line to the northeast corner of survey No. 371, thence westward along the north side of that No. and on in a straight line back. the right bank of the Nirdipoya.

West.- Thence northward along that bank of the same stream to the southernmost point of survey No. 348, thence in a Straight line eastward to the southwest corner of survey No. 367; thence the south side of that number to its southeast corner, thence in a straight line to the southernmost point of survey No. 365 which is also the south west corner of survey No. 351, thence along the south and east sides of survey No. 351 till where it turns north west; thence in a straight line to the easternmost corner of the same number; thence north westward to its northernmost point and then westward along its north side to the easternmost corner of survey No. 353; thence the northeast and the northwest sides of that number to the north east corner of survey No. 355; thence north northwest to the northeast corner of survey No. 349.B; then westward along the north side of the last mentioned number and then southward along its west side for about five chains, thence south, south west to the north east corner of survey No. 344-A, thence westward along the north sides of survey Nos. 344-A and 344 to the south east corner of survey No. 343-A. thence northward along the east side of that number to its north east corner; then in a straight line northwards to the east side of survey No. 3toO; then that side to its northernmost point; thence in a straight line south westward along its north west side to where it turns southwest; thence in a straight line to the north west corner of survey No. 339; and thence on to the northernmost point of survey No. 321; then along the north west side of the last mentioned number till it turns southwest; thence westward to the north east corner of survey No. 318; thence north eastward to the southernmost point of survey No. 301 and then along the south east side of that number to its easternmost point;. thence to the southernmost point of" survey No. 300; then along the south east side of that number to its easternmost point; thence on in a north northeasterly direction to the eastern extremity of survey No. 298; thence its north east side to its northernmost point and thence to the eastern extremity of survey No. 293; then its north east side to the northern extremity thereof; thence it continues to the south east corner of survey No. 274; then its east side to its north east corner; thence north; slightly east to the eastern

extremity of survey No. 276 on the boundary between Kuppattod and Pankanthore desoms (all the foregoing numbers belong to Kuppattod desom) from the last mentioned point the reserve boundary continues north northeast to the north east corner of survey No 159-A, of Pakanthore desom, the southernmost point of Dasankara kunnu; then turns north westward to the northernmost point of survey No. 161; thence slightly more north to the south east corner of survey No. 156, then passing round the number 110 as to exclude it from the reserve to its north west corner; thence it passes along the north side of survey No. 155 to the south east corner of survey No. 154; thence excluding that number it passes round its east and north sides to the northwest corner, then along the north and west sides of survey No. 155 to the westernmost point of that number thence it turns due west a short distance to the right bank of the Panamaram river about one furlong south to the junction of that stream with the Kabani river; then passing down the right bank of the river i.e., northwards it passes the above mentioned junction and continues along the conjoined rivers bank to a point south of where the river splits into two branches to form the Kuruva island, the exact point being north northeast of the extreme northern point of survey 148; then leaving the river so as to exclude the lands included in survey Nos. 147, 148, 149 150, 151 and 153, it passes south to the northern extremity of survey No. 148, then down its west side and the west sides to survey Nos. 149, 153 and 151 eastwards along the south side of survey Nos. 151 and 148 to the westernmost corner of survey No. 153 and then along the southwest; southeast and north east sides of survey Nos. 153, east side of survey No. 148 and the south east and east side of survey No. 147 to the north east corner of the last number, thence due north back to the right bank of the river; thence the river bank eastward to the point at which a straight line joining the southernmost and western most points of survey No. 144 would if reduced, intersect it; thence to the westernmost point of survey No. 144 and on to the southernmost point of the same number, thence south east to the southernmost point of survey No. 174, thence to the south west corner of survey 177, then along its south side to its south east corner, thence to the south west corner of survey No. 193, thence along the south side of that number to its south eastern corner, then the west, south and east sides of survey No. 194 to the south west corner of survey No. 196 then along the south and east sides of survey No. 196 to its north east corner; thence in a straight line to the southern most point of survey No. 197; thence along its east side to its north east corner, thence eastward along the south sides of survey Nos. 198 and 198-A to the west side of survey No. 206-A, then that side to the northern most point of survey No. 207; then along the west and south sides of survey No. 207, the south east and north sides of survey No. 206 to the south eastern corner of survey No. 206.A, thence its east and north sides up to a point about one hundred yards west of its north east corner; thence to the

northernmost point of survey No. 198.A, thence passing north north west the boundary touches the north eastern corner of survey No. 205 and goes on slightly more west to the northernmost point of survey No. 200, then crossing survey No. 198, it passes to the southeast corner of survey No. 294*A, then turning north it passes up the east side of that number and then west north west along its north side to its northernmost point, thence it continues to the north east corner of survey No. 142 and on in a straight line for about one hundred yards to the right bank of the eastern arm of the Kabani river which bank it follows northward to a point about half a furlong southwest of the southernmost point of survey No. 114, then turns eastward to the south west corner of Survey No. 116, then along the south side of this number to its south east corner; then turns north north east to the south east corner of survey No. 122; then it passes along the east and north sides of the last mentioned number to its northernmost point; thence in a straight line slightly north of west to the northernmost corner of survey No. 110, thence along its north side it continues back to the right bank of the eastern arm of the Kabani river; then turning north along the river bank to the point at which a prolongation of the line between the westernmost points of survey Nos. 94 and 296 (all of Pakandlore desom) meets it, which is the starting point.

Remarks: (A) The following enclosures are admitted within the reserve; themselves free from reservation:

(i) Enclosure No.1 Comprising survey Nos. 37 and 38 of Pakanthore desom; Access IS by P.R.W. No.1.

(ii) Enclosure No. II. Comprising Survey Nos. 10, 11, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18,19,20,21,22,23,24,25, 25-A,. 27,28,29 and 299 of Pakanthore desom. Access is by P.R.W. No. I.

(iii) Enclosure No. II Comprising survey Nos. 167 and 168 of Pakanthore desom; Access is by P.R.W. No. VI.

(iv') Enclosure No. IV. Comprising survey Nos. 164, 165 and 166 of Pakanthore desom and survey' Nos. 359, 360, 360-A, 360-B, 361, 362 of Kuppathod desom; Access is by P.R.W. No. IV.

(v) Enclosure No. V. Comprising survey Nos. 213, 213B, 214 and 215 of Pakanthore desom and Nos. 14, 14-A and 15 of Vellyambam desom; access is by P.R.W. No. IV.

(vi) Enclosure No. VI : Formed by survey No. 131 of Vellyambam desom; access is by P.R.W. No. III.

(B) The following rights of way are admitted within the reserve:

- (i) Right of way across the reserve for men and cattle and passing through enclosures Nos. I and II to a width for six feet. It enters the reserve at the elbow on the Kabani river to the east of the group of islands and passes through it eastward: for two and half furlongs; quitting it at the north-west corner of Survey No. 37 ; then passing southward across survey Nos. 37 and 38, it enters the reserve at the south-west corner of the latter number, passing through it in a south south-easterly direction three furlongs enters enclosure No. II at the northern most point of survey No. 25-A, therein crossing that enclosure it re-enters the reserve at the south-east corner of survey No. 14, passes through it in a south-easterly direction some three and three-fourth furlongs and finally quits it at the northernmost point of survey No. 292 (all the above survey numbers being of Pakkanthore desom.)
- (ii) Right of way for men, cattle and carts, being the forest road between Kartikulam and Chedleth, is admitted to a width of twelve feet. It enters the reserve on the right bank of the Kabani river, half a mile north of the junction therewith of the Panamaram river and passes through it in a generally south-easterly direction for over seven miles quitting it on the boundary between Vellyambam and Pulpalli desoms, a quarter mile north of the Narmalai 'kunnu' (hill).
- (iii) Right of way to a width of six feet for men and cattle to enclosure No. VI enters the reserve on the right bank of Niridi poya, about *half* a mile east of the trijunction of the Kuppatoode. Vellyambam and Pudadi desoms, and passes through it in an east north easterly direction, nearly three furlongs quitting it twenty yards east of the south west corner of the Enclosure VI survey No. 131 of Vellyambam desom.
- (iv) Right of way across the reserve to enclosure Nos. IV and V to a width of six feet for men and cattle. It enters the reserve from survey No. 159-A of Pakanthoredesom, about fifty yards from the easternmost corner of survey No. 276 and passes through it southeastward for *two* furlon's6, . quitting it at the westernmost corner of survey No. 161 of enclosure. No. IV crossing that enclosure it re-enters the reserve near the easternmost corner of survey No. 36(1-B of Kuppatoode desom, passes east south-east through it three-fourth, of a mile and enters enclosure No. V on its west side, crossing this enclosure it finally re-enters the reserve at the middle of the east side of survey No. 215 of Pakanthore desom, passes east north-east through it for one and three-fourth furlongs and finally quits it at the westernmost point of survey No. 216 of the same desom.

- (v) Right of way across the reserve at its narrowest point is admitted to a width of six feet for men and cattle. It enters the reserve at the southernmost point of survey No. 131 of Pakanthore desom passes through it first south-east for one and a half furlongs and nearly due east for two and a half furlongs and quits it at the north-west corner of survey No. 281 also of Pakanthore desom.
- (vi) Rights of way of enclosure No. III is provided to a width of six feet for men and cattle. It branches from the Kartikollam-Chedleth forest road (P.R.W. No. II above) at a point one and a half miles after that road enters the reserve and south south-west of the enclosure, passes through the reserve north north-eastward one and a half furlongs to the southern extremity of survey No. 167 of Pakanthore desom.
