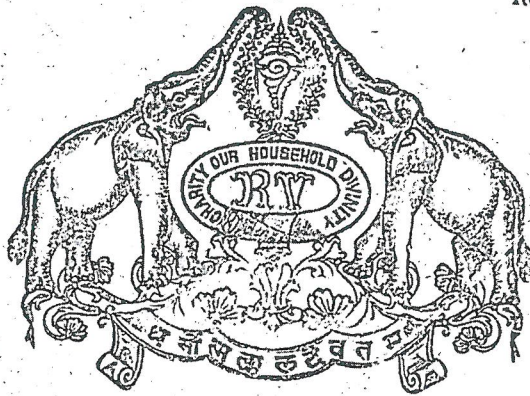

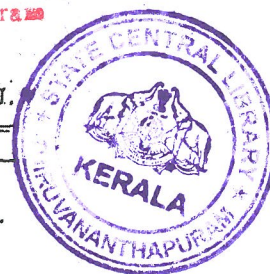

The portion of the Shaliakara Estate road 30 feet broad entering the Reserved Forest just north of cairn No. 147 and running in a northwesterly direction for about 5 chains and thence in a northeasterly direction for about 30 chains and leaves the Reserved Forest between cairn Nos. 164 and 165.</p> <p>The same road also gives access to the admitted land (S. No 153/18) under I. Lands described above, by touching its ring boundary at its cairn No. 8.</p> <p>2. One foot-path 6 feet broad and 12 chains long enters the Reserve between cairn Nos. 13 and 14 on the north boundary of the Reserve and running in a southeast direction leaves the Reserve just south west of cairn No. 38 on the north side of S. No. 182/1.</p> <p>3. Another road 30 links wide enters the Reserve north of cairn No. 54 on the main eastern boundary and goes in a north west direction for about 9 chains, thence southeast for about 9½ chains, thence south southeast for about 8 chains, thence east for about 4½ chains and thence more or less southeast for about 12 chains and meets the northern boundary of the enclosure (14 acres of land) west of its cairn No. 4 and thus gives access to the same.</p> <p>There are no other claims either private or public within the Reserve.</p>	365 acres.
