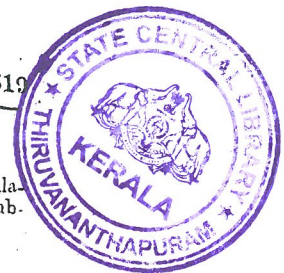

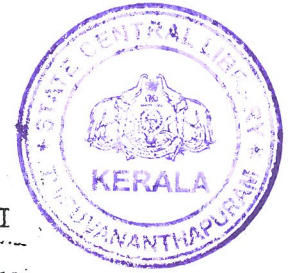

Chengannur.	<p><i>Situation.</i></p> <p>The Reserve lies to the North and West of the Pambay River and consists of the major portion of survey number 170/1 of Ranni village, Chengannur taluk.</p> <p><i>North.</i>—Starting from cairn No. 1 situated 20 chains east north-east of the south-east corner of survey number 150/3 of Ranni village in Chengannur taluk, the line runs east north-east in a straight line for about 68 chains to cairn No. 32 situated about 2 chains south-east of the south-west corner of survey number 170/1/34, thence south-east for about 8½ chains to cairn No. 33 situated about a chain south-east of the south-east corner of the above survey number, thence south south-west for about 5 chains to cairn No. 34 about 2 chains west by slightly north of the south-west corner of survey number 150/1/35, thence south-east for about 6½ chains to cairn No. 35 about 1½ chains south-east of the south-east corner of 170/1/35, thence north north-east for about 5 chains to cairn No. 36 about 1½ chains south-east from a point on the eastern boundary of survey number 170/1/35, 9½ chains south from its north-east corner, thence south-east for about 3½ chains to cairn No. 37, thence north-east for about 4 chains to cairn No. 38, thence north north-west for about 14½ chains passing cairn No. 39 to cairn No. 40, thence north-west for about 16½ chains passing cairn No. 41 to cairn No. 42, thence north by slightly east for about 10 chains passing cairn No. 43 to cairn No. 44, thence north north-west for about 9½ chains to cairn No. 45 at the Revenue Survey stone about 2 chains north of the south-east corner of survey number 169/2, thence in a south-easterly direction along the north side of survey number 170/1 for about 45½ chains and passing cairn Nos. 45 to 54 to cairn No. 55, thence east north-east for about 20 chains along the north side of this survey number passing cairn Nos. 56 to 61 to cairn No. 62 at the north-west corner of survey number 172/1.</p> <p><i>East.</i>—Thence south by slightly east for about 15½ chains passing cairn Nos. 63 and 64 to cairn No. 65 situated about 2 chains north-west of the south-west corner of survey number 172/1, thence east south-east for about 5 chains to cairn No. 66 about 3 chains east south-east of the south-west corner of that number, thence south by slightly east for about 22½ chains passing cairn Nos. 67 to 69 to cairn No. 70, thence south-east for about 11 chains passing cairn Nos. 71 and 72 to cairn No. 73, thence south by slightly west for about 24 chains passing cairn Nos. 74 to 76 to cairn No. 77, thence east by slightly south for about 1½ chains to cairn No. 78, thence south-east for about 16½ chains passing cairn Nos. 79 to 81 to cairn No. 82, thence north north-east for about 14 chains passing cairn No. 83 to cairn No. 84, thence south-east for about 11½ chains passing cairn Nos. 85 and 86 to cairn No. 87 about 6 chains west by slightly north of the south-west corner of survey No. 179/2, thence south south-east for about 24½ chains passing cairn Nos. 88 and 89 to cairn No. 90 about 2½ chains north-east of the northern most point of survey number 181/1, thence west south-west for about 10½ chains passing cairn Nos. 91 and 92 to cairn No. 93 about 3½ chains north-west of the north-west corner of survey number 181/1, thence south for about 2½ chains to cairn No. 94 about 8½ chains west of the north-west corner of survey number 181/1, thence south south-east for about 10 chains passing cairn No. 95 to cairn No. 96, thence south-east for about 14 chains passing cairn No. 97 to cairn No. 98, thence south for about 17½ chains passing cairn Nos. 99 to 101 to cairn No. 102 about 2½ chains west of the south-west corner of survey number 184/1, thence west north-west for about 2½</p>	3 sq. miles 215 acres.	There are no public or private rights within the reserve except survey number 170/1—72, which is a private holding having an extent of 7.63 acres registered in the name of Sankaran Krishnan, Thottupuzha house, Arattupuzha muri, Aramulam.



Chains passing cairn No. 103 to cairn No. 104, thence west for about $5\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 105, situated $5\frac{1}{2}$ chains north-west of the north-west corner of the survey number 184/3, thence south by slightly west for about $15\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn Nos. 106 to 109 to cairn No. 110, thence west south-west for about $3\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 111, thence west by slightly south for about 6 chains passing cairn Nos. 112 and 113 to cairn No. 114 about 8 chains north-west of the south-west corner of survey number 185/1, thence south-west by slightly south for about 8 chains to cairn No. 115, thence south south-west for about $24\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn Nos. 116 to 120 to cairn No. 121, thence south by slightly east for about $1\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 122, thence south-east for about $8\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn No. 123 to cairn No. 124 about $9\frac{1}{2}$ chains north-west of the north-east corner of survey number 188/2, thence south south-west for about 6 chains to cairn No. 125 about 2 chains south south-west of the north-west corner of survey number 188/2.

South.—Thence west north-west for about $15\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn Nos. 126 to 128 to cairn No. 129, thence south south-west for about $13\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn No. 130 to cairn No. 131, thence north-west for about 50 chains passing cairn Nos. 132 to 134 to cairn No. 135, thence north north-west for about $17\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn Nos. 136 and 137 to cairn No. 138, thence north north-east for about 5 chains passing cairn No. 139 to cairn No. 140, thence west north-west for about 4 chains to cairn No. 141, thence north north-west for about $12\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 142, thence west north-west for about $5\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 143, thence north west for about $15\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn Nos. 144 and 145 to cairn No. 146, thence north-east for about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 147, thence north north-west for about 3 chains to cairn No. 148, thence west north-west for about $5\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 149, thence north north-west for about 2 chains to cairn No. 150, thence west by slightly south for about 8 chains passing cairn No. 151 to cairn No. 152, thence south-west for about $12\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn No. 153 to cairn No. 154, thence more or less in a north-westerly direction for about $23\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn Nos. 155 to 158 to cairn No. 159, thence south south-west for about 8 chains to cairn No. 160, thence south south-east for about 3 chains to cairn No. 161, thence east south-east for about 25 chains passing cairn Nos. 162 and 163 to cairn No. 164, thence south-west by slightly south for about $4\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn No. 165 to cairn No. 166, thence west by slightly north for about 25 chains passing cairn Nos. 167 to 169 to cairn No. 170 thence south-west for about 5 chains to cairn No. 171 situated about 3 chains north of the north-east corner of survey number 203/5.

West.—Thence north for about $21\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn Nos. 172 and 173 to cairn No. 174, thence north by slightly west for about 10 chains passing cairn No. 175 to cairn No. 176, thence north-west for about 12 chains to cairn No. 177, thence south-west for about 4 chains to cairn No. 178 about 1 chain north north-east of the northernmost point of survey number 205/3, thence north-west for about $19\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn No. 179 to cairn No. 180, thence north north-west for about $5\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn No. 181 to cairn No. 182 about 3 chains east of the north-east corner of survey number 206/4, thence north by slightly east for about $7\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 183 about 5 chains north-east of the north-east corner of survey number 143/1, thence north-east for about 2 chains to cairn No. 184, thence south-east for about 9 chains passing cairn No. 185 to cairn No. 186, thence north-east for about $21\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn Nos. 187 and 188 to cairn No. 189, thence south-east for about 18 chains passing cairn No. 190 to cairn No. 191, thence east for about 5 chains to cairn No. 192, thence north for about $3\frac{1}{2}$ chains to cairn No. 193, thence north-west for about $12\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn Nos. 194 and 195 to cairn No. 196, thence north by slightly west for about 6 chains to cairn No. 197, thence north north-west for about 14 chains passing cairn Nos. 198 and 199 to cairn No. 200, thence north-east for about $3\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing cairn No. 201 to cairn No. 1 at the starting point.

NOTE. The right of way to the registered holding is by a six feet trace entering the Reserve at Cairn No. 93 on its eastern side. This trace going first in a west north-westerly direction for about 8 chains and thence more or less in a westerly direction for about 6 chains enters the registered holding on its southern side.
