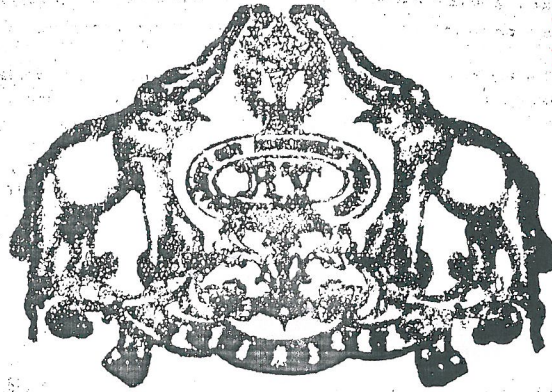

TENDER NOTICE.

RE: THE EXPLOITATION OF TIMBERS FROM THE SOUTHERN FOREST DIVISION.

Tenders are hereby invited for the collection and delivery of the undernoted quantities of timbers from the localities mentioned in the schedule hereunder during the periods noted against each subject to the following conditions:—

2. Tenders should clearly state the kolevila required per cubic foot of timbers selling at and above tariff value and the percentage of the sale proceeds limited to fixed kolevila for those selling below tariff.

N. B.—No percentage more than 45 per cent. will be allowed in the case of royalties.

3. Tenders should be addressed to the Divisional Forest Officer, Southern Division in sealed covers superscribed "Tenders for the collection and delivery oftimbers from.....to.....Depot". Tenders should be registered when sent by Anchal or Post.

4. Each tender should be accompanied by a sum of earnest money as specified in the schedule without which no notice will be taken of the tender.

5. Tenders should reach the Divisional Forest Officer before 1 P. M. on the date noted in the schedule. They will be opened by the Divisional Forest Officer in his office at Trivandrum at 3 P. M. on the same day in the presence of such of the tenderers as may choose to be present on the occasion.

6. The lowest tender will be accepted provided the character and financial status of the tenderer be found satisfactory, but the Divisional Forest Officer, reserves to himself the right of accepting or rejecting any tender without assigning any reason therefor. The acceptance of the tender is subject to the approval of the Conservator of Forests. The tender cannot be withdrawn before the final decision of its acceptance.

7. The successful tenderer will have to execute an agreement on an 8 anna stamp paper within 20 days from the date of communication of the acceptance of his tender and before signing it he will have to deposit in the Srekar Savings Bank as security, the amount at 8 cash per cubic foot pledging the security to the Divisional Forest Officer. On production of the Pass Book in support of the remittance of the security, the earnest money paid with the tender will be arranged to be refunded. The earnest money of the unsuccessful tenderers will be returned to them immediately their tenders are disposed of.

Cairns have been erected along the boundaries of the reserve and a correct description of the boundaries with reference to the cairns is hereto appended for the information of the public.

Situation. This reserve is situated north of Karkulam village, south of the Pathayakallu Thodu and west of Shethacal reserve and comprises of Survey Nos. 790/1-3, 4, 6, 19 and 23 and portions of survey Nos. 790/1-9, 17 A, 18, 20, 21, 22, and 24 of Rani pakuthi.

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION.

North. Starting from cairn No. 1 situated at the eastern-most corner of survey No 794/1 of Ranni pakuthi, Pathanamthitta Taluk, the line runs north-east for about 7 chains along the southern limit of survey No. 790/1-18 to cairn No. 2 at the south-east corner of survey No. 793/1; thence more or less in the same direction for about 5 chains along the eastern limit of that survey number to cairn No. 3 at the western most corner of survey No. 790/1-15, thence east south-east for about 17 3/4 chains along the southern limit of survey No. 790/1-15 passing cairn Nos. 4 to 6 to cairn No. 7 at the south-east corner of that survey number (790/1-15); thence south south-east for about 7 1/2 chains passing cairn No. 8 to cairn No. 9; thence south-east for about 16 chains passing cairn Nos. 10 to 13 to cairn No. 14 at a point on the western boundary of survey No. 790/1-25 B about 5 chains north of its south-west corner; thence south-west for about 3 1/2 chains passing cairn No. 15 to cairn No. 16; thence more or less south south-east for about 20 1/4 chains along the western limits of the rubber plantation in the south-east corner of survey No. 790/1-24 and survey No. 790/1-7 passing cairn Nos. 17 to 21 to cairn No. 22 at the south-west corner of the latter survey number 790/1-7; thence east north-east for about 38 3/4 chains along the southern limits of survey Nos. 790/1-7, 25 A & C passing cairn Nos. 23 to 31 to cairn No. 32 at a theodolite station at the south-east corner of the last survey number (cairn No. 32 is built on the western boundary of the Shethacal Reserved Forest between cairn Nos. 182 and 183) thence south for about 10 chains along the western limit of survey No. 803/1 passing cairn Nos. 33 and 34 to cairn No. 35 situated at the south-west corner of that survey number; thence east south-east for about 16 1/2 chains along the southern limit of that survey number (803/1) passing cairn Nos. 36 to 33 to cairn No. 39 at its south-east corner; thence north-east for about 6 1/4 chains along the eastern limit of that survey number to cairn No. 40 at its north-east corner (about 2 chains south-east of cairn No. 178 on the western boundary of the Shethacal reserved forest).

East. Thence south-east for about 46 1/4 chains along the western boundary of the Shethacal reserved forest (i. e., along the western boundary of survey number 781/1) passing cairn numbers 41 to 46 to cairn No. 47 at the north east corner of survey number 790/1-17 B; thence west south-west for 3 chains along the northern limit of survey number 790/1-17 B to cairn number 48 at its north-west corner; thence south for 3 chains along the western limit of that survey number to cairn number 49; thence south south-east for about 9 chains along the said limit passing cairn number 50 to cairn No. 51 at its south-west corner; thence south-west for about 15 1/2 chains passing cairn numbers 52 and 53 to cairn No. 53 on the northern boundary of the Karingulathumala Reserved Forest.

South. Thence west but slightly north for about 33 1/2 chains along the northern limit of survey number 170/1 (i. e., a portion of the northern boundary of the Karingulathumala Reserved Forest from cairn numbers 53, 52, 51, 50, 49, 48, 47 and 46 to cairn number 45 of that reserve); thence north-east for about 8 1/2 chains to cairn number 54 at the south-east corner of survey number 169/1; thence north but slightly west for about 3 1/4 chains along the eastern limit of that survey number 169/1 to cairn number 55 at its north east corner; thence north-west for about 21 chains passing cairn numbers 56 and 57 to cairn number 58; thence west north-west along the western limit of survey number 790/1-4 for about 17 3/4 chains passing cairn numbers 59 and 60 to cairn number 61 at its westernmost corner; thence south-west for about 33 chains passing cairn numbers 62 to 68 to cairn number 67 at the north-east corner of survey number 164/2; thence west for about 5 3/4 chains along the northern limit of survey number 164/2 to cairn number 68 at its north-west corner; thence south for about 2 3/4 chains along its western limit passing cairn number 69 to cairn number 70; thence south south-east for about 9 1/2 chains passing cairn numbers 71 and 72 to cairn number 73 at a theodolite stone situated at the north east corner of survey number 164/1; thence south west for about

Thence north but slightly west for about 11 1/2 chains along the eastern limit of survey number 790/1-8 passing cairn number 79 to cairn number 80 at its north-east corner; thence north-west for about 8 3/4 chains along the northern limit of survey number 798/1 passing cairn number 81 and the Vilakumara Thodu to cairn number 82 at its north-west corner; thence north north-east for about 16 1/2 chains along the eastern limits of survey numbers 797/1 and 2 passing cairn No. 83 and the Vilakumara Thodu to cairn number 84 at the north-east corner of the latter survey number; thence west north-west for about 10 3/4 chains along the northern limit of survey number 797/2 passing the Vilakumara Thodu and cairn numbers 85 and 86 to cairn number 87 at its north-west corner; thence north for about 20 chains passing cairn numbers 88 to 91 to cairn number 92; thence north north-west for about 24 3/4 chains passing cairn numbers 92 to 96 to cairn number 97; thence north-west for about 13 3/4 chains passing cairn numbers 98 to 100 to cairn number 1 at the starting point at the northern boundary.

Survey number 790/1-3 having an extent of one acre is included into the reserve after giving in exchange (survey number 790/21-147) an equal area in extent from survey number 790/21 outside the reserve west of survey number 164/3 A of the Raji pakhuti as per Government sanction conveyed in their R. O. C. number 5594/28] Devpt., dated 2nd August 1933 and as per registered deed number 342, dated 14th Kanni 1111 of the Pathanamthitta Sub-Registrar's Office.
