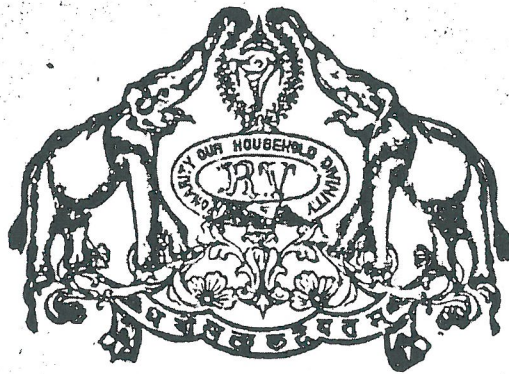

NOTIFICATION.

With the sanction of His Highness the Maha Raja it is hereby notified under Section 19 of the Travancore Forest Regulation II of 1068 as amended by Regulations I of 1071, IX of 1085, IV of 1089 and VIII of 1097, that the tract specified in the subjoined schedule shall be deemed to be a Reserved Forest with effect from the date of publication of this notification in the Gazette.

Cairns have been erected along the boundaries of the reserve and a correct description of the boundaries with reference to the cairns is hereto appended for the information of the public.

Situation:—The Block is situated about 2 1/2 miles south east of the Edamann Railway Station and to the south of the Quilon-Shencotta road between the 34th and 36th miles and to the north of the Punalur river and comprises portions of survey numbers 23/1, 24/1 and 2 and 28/1 of Pathanapuram pakuthi and portion of S. No. 8/2/1 of Anchal pakuthi.

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION:

North:—Starting from cairn No. 1 on the eastern side of the Yerur Edamann village road at the theodolite stone opposite the Forest Guard Station at Edamann on the eastern boundary of S. No. 29/8 of Pathanapuram pakuthi at the junction of the above road with the Quilon-Shencottah road, the line goes east southeast along the southern side of the latter road for a distance of about 124 1/2 chains to the bridge over the Andoorpatcha stream.

East:—Thence the line goes more or less south east along the Andoorpatcha stream (the western boundary of the Aryankavu Reserved Forest) for a distance of about 41 chains to cairn No. 2 on the western boundary of S. No. 23/2 of Pathanapuram pakuthi at the point where the stream enters into it, thence south south east for about 3 3/4 chains passing cairn Nos. 3 and 4 to cairn No. 5 at the theodolite stone, thence south east for about 7 1/4 chains to cairn No. 6 at the south west corner of S. No. 23/2, thence north east for about 5 3/4 chains to cairn No. 7 at its south eastern corner, thence north west for about 3 1/2 chains to cairn No. 8 at a theodolite stone, thence west north west for about 4 1/2 chains to cairn No. 9, thence north west for about 3 1/4 chains to cairn No. 10 at the point where the Andoorpatcha stream leaves the survey number (the boundary from cairn No. 2 to cairn No. 10 skirts S. No. 23/2; thence east south east for about 28 chains along the above stream (the western boundary of the Aryankavu Reserved Forest) till its junction with the Punalur river.

South:—Thence the line goes more or less in a westerly direction for about 236 3/4 chains along the Punalur river (the northern boundary of the Yerur Reserved Forest) to cairn No. 11 on its right bank near the Ayimallure crossing of the Yerur Edamann road at a point about 2 1/2 chains west of cairn No. 12 at the south east corner of S. No. 27/1 of Pathanapuram pakuthi and about 1 3/4 chains south of the village boundary stone on the western boundary of that S. No. (27/1).

West:—Thence east for about 2 1/2 chains along the southern side of the above road to cairn No. 12 at the south east corner of S. No. 27/1, thence north east for about 3/4 chain to cairn No. 13 on the eastern boundary of S. No. 28/1 at the turning of the above road, thence south, south east for about 3 1/2 chains along the eastern boundary of the above said S. No. 28/1 to cairn No. 14, thence again south east for about 3 1/4 chains passing cairn No. 15 to cairn No. 16, thence east by slightly north for about 2 1/4 chains passing cairn No. 17 to cairn No. 18, thence north northwest for about 5 chains passing cairn No. 19 to cairn No. 20, thence north for about 7 1/4 chains to cairn No. 21, thence north northwest for about 2 3/4 chains to cairn No. 22, thence north west for about 5 chains passing cairn No. 23 to cairn No. 24, thence north north west for about 4 1/4 chains to cairn No. 25, thence north north east for about 13 1/4 chains to cairn No. 26, thence north west for about 1 1/4 chain to cairn No. 27, thence west by slightly north for about 4 1/2 chains passing cairn No. 28 to cairn No. 29 on the eastern side of the Yerur Edamann road at a point about 3 3/4 chains south east of the theodolite stone on the western side of the above road at the south east corner of S. No. 29/1, thence more or less north for about 23 chains along the eastern side of the above said road to cairn No. 1 at the starting point.

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION.

North :—Starting from cairn No. 1 at the north west corner of the enclosure (S. No. 23/1-2) the line goes east south east for about 11 chains passing cairn No. 2 to cairn No. 3 on the north east corner of the enclosure.

East :—Thence south southwest for about 10 3/4 chains passing cairn Nos. 4 and 5 to cairn No. 6 at the south east corner of the enclosure.

South :—Thence west northwest for about 9 1/2 chains passing cairn Nos. 7 and 8 to cairn No. 9, thence north west for about 2 chains to cairn No. 10 at the south west corner of the enclosure.

West :—Thence north north east for about 10 chains passing cairn Nos. 11 and 12 to cairn No. 1 at the starting point.

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION.

North :—Starting from cairn No. 1 at the north west corner of the enclosure the line goes east south east for about 2 chains to cairn No. 2 near the north west corner of S. No. 22/1-A, thence east by slightly south for about 4 chains passing cairn No. 3 to cairn No. 4, thence north east for about 1 3/4 chains to cairn No. 5.

East :—Thence south south east for about 6 chains to cairn No. 6, thence south south east for about 3 chains to cairn No. 7, thence south by slightly east for about 1 chain to cairn No. 8, thence south east for about 6 1/2 chains to cairn No. 9 near the easternmost corner of S. No. 22/1-B, thence south by slightly west for about 10 1/2 chains passing cairn Nos. 10 and 11 to cairn No. 12 near the south east corner of S. No. 22/1-B, thence south by slightly east for about 3 chains to cairn No. 13 at the south east corner of the enclosure.

South :—Thence west for about 1 chain to cairn No. 14, thence north by slightly west for about 2 chains to cairn No. 15, thence north west for about 1 3/4 chains to cairn No. 16 at the south west corner of S. No. 22/1-B.

West :—Thence north by slightly east for about 7 3/4 chains passing cairn No. 17 to cairn No. 18, thence north north west for about 3 1/4 chains to cairn No. 19, thence north west for about 2 1/4 chains to cairn No. 20, thence north by slightly east for about 5 1/4 chains to cairn No. 21, thence west north west for about 7 chains passing cairn No. 22 to cairn No. 23, thence north west for about 2 chains to cairn No. 24 at the westernmost corner of the enclosure, thence north east for about 1 chain to cairn No. 1 at the starting point.

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION.

North:—Starting from cairn No. 1 at a theodolite stone on the north west corner of S. No. 24/15 the line goes east by slightly south for about 3 3/4 chains to cairn No. 2, thence east for about 2 1/4 chains to cairn No. 3, thence south east for about 1 3/4 chains to cairn No. 4, thence north east for about 2 chains passing cairn No. 5, to cairn No. 6, thence north by slightly west for about 3 chains to cairn No. 7 at the north west corner of S. No. 24/5, thence south west for about 1 1/2 a chain to cairn No. 8, thence north west for about 1 3/4 chains to cairn No. 9, thence north north east for about 3 1/2 chains to cairn No. 10, thence east by slightly north for about 1 1/2 a chain to cairn No. 11 at the north west corner of S. No. 24/4, thence north west for about 4 chains to cairn No. 12, thence east north east for about 3 3/4 chains to cairn No. 13, thence east for about 1 1/4 chains to cairn No. 14, thence south by slightly east for about 4 1/4 chains passing cairn No. 15 to cairn No. 16 at the south east corner of S. No. 24/3-18, thence east for about 1/4 of a chain to cairn No. 17, thence south south east for about 2 chains to cairn No. 18, thence west for about 1/4 of a chain to cairn No. 19 at the north eastern most corner of S. No. 24/5, thence south south east for about 4 1/4 chains to cairn No. 20, thence south east for about 2 chains to cairn No. 21 at the north west corner of S. No. 24/8, thence east north east for about 5 chains to cairn No. 22, thence east by slightly south for about 2 1/4 chains to cairn No. 23 at the north east corner of S. No. 24/8, thence south east for about 3 1/2 chains to cairn No. 24.

East:—Thence south east for about 1 3/4 chains to cairn No. 25, thence south south-west for about 2 3/4 chains to cairn No. 26, thence west south-west for about 1 1/2 chains to cairn No. 27, thence south west for about 2 1/4 chains to cairn No. 28, thence west for about 2 1/4 chains to cairn No. 29 at the north-east corner of S. No. 24/11, thence south-west for about 1 3/4 chains to cairn No. 30 at the south-east corner of S. No. 24/11, thence south-east for about 2 1/4 chains to cairn No. 31, thence south by slightly east for about 3 1/4 chains passing cairn Nos. 32 to cairn No. 33 at the south-east corner of S. No. 24/12.

South:—Thence west south-west for about 1 chain to cairn No. 34, thence north-west for about 6 chains passing cairn Nos. 35 and 36 to cairn No. 37 at the south-east corner of S. No. 24/13, thence south west for about 1/2 a chain to cairn No. 38, thence west by slightly north for about 6 1/2 chains passing cairn No. 39 to cairn No. 40, thence north-west for about 5 3/4 chains passing cairn No. 41 to cairn No. 42 at the north-west corner of S. No. 24/14, thence west for about 2 1/4 chains passing cairn No. 43 to cairn No. 44, thence west north-west for about 4 chains to cairn No. 45 at the south-west corner of S. No. 24/15.

West:—Thence north north-east for about 3 3/4 chains to cairn No. 1 at the starting point.
N. B.—Cairns Nos. 1 to 7, 11 to 16, 19 to 21, 23 to 25, 27 to 30, 33, 34 and 36 to 45 are erected at the theodolite stones.

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION.

North:—Starting from cairn No. 1 at the north west corner of S. No. 24/16 the line goes east by slightly south for about 6 1/4 chains passing cairn Nos. 2 and 3 to cairn No. 4 at the north east corner of the said survey number.

East:—Thence south east for about 3 chains to cairn No. 5, thence south for about 2 chains to cairn No. 6 at the south east corner of S. No. 24/16.

South:—Thence west south west for about 13 1/2 chains passing cairn Nos. 7 and 8 to cairn No. 9 at the westernmost corner of the enclosure.

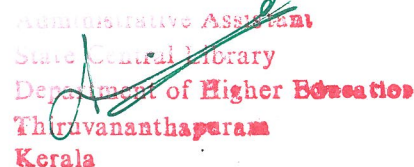
West:—Thence north by slightly west for about 1 1/4 chains to cairn No. 10, thence north north-east for about 3 chains to cairn No. 11, thence east north-east for about 4 1/4 chains to cairn No. 12 at a point about 1/2 a chain north of the theodolite stone on the western boundary of S. No. 24/16, thence north by slightly west for about 3 3/4 chains to cairn No. 1 at the starting point.

N. B.—Cairns Nos. 1 to 6 are erected at the theodolite stones.

PUBLIC RIGHTS WITHIN THE RESERVE.

II. RIGHTS OF WAYS.

1. The right to use by men and cattle of a footpath 6 feet broad starting from cairn No. 13 on the outer boundary of the reserve and going towards east through the reserve for a distance of about 1/2 a chain, enters the enclosure boundary of S. Nos. 24/16 and 17 at a point about 1 1/2 chains south of cairn No. 11 on the same boundary.
