**ORDER**

1. The following Ex-cadre posts of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests are created in the scale of pay 67,000-79,000 and these posts are declared equivalent in status and responsibility to the cadre post of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Development & Project) Thiruvananthapuram under Rule 9 of IFS (Pay) Rules 1968.

- i) Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Bio-Diversity Cell).
- ii) Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (FMIS).

2. The following promotions and postings of IFS Officers of 1982 batch are ordered with immediate effect.

a. Shri. G.Harikumar IFS (KL: 82), Chief Conservator of Forests (Tribal Mission) is promoted to the grade of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in the scale of pay Rs. 67,000-79,000 and posted as Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Administration) in the existing vacancy.

b. Shri. Vinod Kumar Uniyal IFS (KL: 82), Chief Conservator of Forests presently working as Scientist, Wild Life Institute of India on Central Deputation is promoted to the grade of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in the scale of pay Rs. 67,000-79,000 on proforma basis.

c. Shri. G.J. Teggi IFS (KL: 82), Chief Conservator of Forests (FMIS) is promoted to the grade of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in the scale of pay Rs. 67,000-79,000 and posted against the ex-cadre post of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (IHRD) vice Shri. A.K.Goyal IFS transferred.

d. Dr. Mehar Singh IFS (KL: 82), Chief Conservator of Forests presently on Study leave is promoted to the grade of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in the scale of pay Rs. 67,000-79,000 on proforma basis.

e. Shri. Lalith Kishore Varshney IFS (KL: 82), Chief Conservator of Forests (Southern Circle) Kollam is promoted to the grade of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in the scale of pay Rs. 67,000-79,000 and posted as Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Regional South) Kollam in the existing vacancy.

f. Shri. C.S. Yalakki IFS (KL: 82), Chief Conservator of Forests who is on compulsory waiting for posting is promoted to the grade of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in the scale of pay Rs. 67,000-79,000 and posted against the ex-cadre post of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Bio-Diversity Cell) created vide (i) of para 1 above. He will also hold the additional charge of Special Officer, Zoological Park, Thrissur.

g. Shri. Winston. S. Suting IFS (KL: 82), Chief Conservator of Forests (Bio-Diversity Cell) is promoted to the grade of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in the scale of pay Rs. 67,000-79,000 and posted as Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Regional North) Kozhikode in the existing vacancy.

3. The following transfers and postings are also ordered with immediate effect.

a. On transfer Shri. A.K.Goyal IFS (KL: 81), Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (IHRD) is posted against the ex-cadre post of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (FMIS) created vide (ii) of para 1 above. He will also hold Additional Charge of Custodian, EFL & Disciplinary Authority for dealing with disciplinary cases at Forest Head Quarters.



b. Shri. G. Mohandas IFS (KL: 88) Chief Conservator of Forests (Tribal Rehabilitation Commissioner) is transferred and posted as Chief Conservator of Forests (Southern Circle) Kollam vice Shri. Lalith Kishore Varshney, IFS promoted as Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests. He will no more hold the Additional Charge of Special Officer, Cashew, Kollam.

c. Shri. Shripal IFS (KL: 86) who is on compulsory waiting for posting is posted as Chief Conservator of Forests & (Tribal Rehabilitation Commissioner) Thiruvananthapuram vice Shri. G. Mohandas transferred.

d. Shri. Nagesh Prabhu IFS (KL: 84) who is holding the charge of Chief Conservator of Forests (Social Forestry) Ernakulam is posted as Chief Conservator of Forests (Social Forestry) Ernakulam in the existing vacancy.

4. The promotion vide para 2 above are ordered with the concurrence of Government of India as stipulated under Rule 3(2)(ii) & (iii) of IFS (Pay) Rules 2007, vide the letter read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above.
