**ORDER NO. E4-4341/10 Dated : 01 .07.2015**

As per the final seniority list of Section Forest Officers published vide reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited , Section Forest Officers upto serial number 240 have been promoted to the cadre of Deputy Range Officers as per proceedings cited 2<sup>nd</sup> above. 9 Deputy Range Officers were retired from service and 2 Deputy Range Officers are under suspension. Thus altogether 11 vacancies arose in the cadre of Deputy Range Officers. In order to fill up the above vacancies of Deputy Range Officers, service particulars of Section Forest Officers as per the Seniority list published vide order read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above have been verified. It is found that the following 10 Section Forest Officers as per the Seniority list are eligible for promotion as Deputy Range Officers.
